I am writing on behalf of **Human Uplift Trust (HUT)** to request your continued support for strengthening educational opportunities for vulnerable children at **Vidyashram – House of Hope**, located in Perambalur district, Tamil Nadu.

Human Uplift Trust was founded with the belief that education has the power to transform lives, particularly for children who grow up facing poverty, stigma, and social exclusion. For nearly two decades, Vidyashram has served as a residential home and learning environment for children affected by HIV, orphanhood, and severe socio-economic hardship. Many of the children who come to us have experienced interrupted schooling, family instability, and social discrimination. Through shelter, education, healthcare, and emotional support, Vidyashram has helped them rebuild confidence and pursue a more hopeful future.

Over the years, more than **250 children** have been supported through Vidyashram's programmes, and we currently care for **85 resident children**. Their resilience and aspirations have encouraged us to strengthen our educational efforts further so that they can compete on equal footing with other students in higher education and employment.

Through our experience, we have learned that **access to strong English-medium education and modern learning resources is critical for long-term opportunity**, particularly for first-generation learners from rural and marginalized communities. Many capable students lose opportunities in higher education simply because they lack early exposure to English-medium instruction and digital learning environments.

With this understanding, Human Uplift Trust has been gradually developing an **English-medium school within the Vidyashram campus** to provide structured and inclusive schooling for these children. This initiative aims to create a safe and supportive educational environment that combines quality academic instruction with the care, stability, and encouragement that vulnerable children require.

We are deeply grateful to **Asha for Education**, whose support over the years has played an important role in sustaining educational activities at Vidyashram. Your encouragement and partnership have helped us expand opportunities for children who otherwise might have been left behind.

As part of the ongoing development of the Vidyashram school, we are presently seeking support for the **construction of one classroom along with essential classroom furniture**. This classroom will contribute to completing the infrastructure required for the functioning of the school and will directly support the learning needs of the children currently residing at Vidyashram.

The broader vision for the Vidyashram school includes safe classrooms, child-friendly learning spaces, access to digital learning tools, laboratories, and a supportive environment where children affected by social and economic disadvantage can study without stigma or interruption.

For the children at Vidyashram, educational support from Asha for Education represents far more than infrastructure. It represents encouragement, confidence, and the belief that their future matters. With improved learning environments and strong academic foundations, these children can pursue higher education, meaningful employment, and independent lives with dignity.

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## EXECUTIVE BRIEF

### **Empowering Futures: Strengthening Inclusive English-Medium Education for HIV-Affected and Socially Disadvantaged Children at Vidyashram, Perambalur**

*(An education-focused initiative aligned with the mission of Asha for Education to expand opportunities for underprivileged children through meaningful grassroots support)*

#### **Project Overview**

Human Uplift Trust (HUT) seeks support from **Asha for Education** to strengthen educational access and quality for HIV-affected and socially disadvantaged children at **Vidyashram** in Perambalur district, Tamil Nadu. Vidyashram is a long-standing residential home and learning centre that currently supports **85 children**, many of whom are HIV-positive, from HIV-affected families, orphaned, or deeply affected by poverty, caste marginalization, abandonment, and disrupted schooling.

For the past 18 years, Vidyashram has provided these children with shelter, food, healthcare, psychosocial care, and non-formal education. Over time, the institution has helped more than **250 children** continue their education and move toward adulthood with dignity and stability. However, experience has also shown that children from highly vulnerable backgrounds continue to face major disadvantages when they move into higher studies or employment because they lack a strong **English-medium foundation**, digital exposure, and access to structured school infrastructure comparable to mainstream institutions.

To address this gap, HUT is in the process of developing a **formal English-medium school** within the Vidyashram campus. The long-term goal is to create a safe, stigma-free, child-friendly educational institution that combines quality schooling with emotional support, health care, and inclusive learning opportunities.

The present proposal to Asha for Education is part of this larger school-development effort and specifically seeks support for the **construction of one classroom**, which will contribute to the completion of the required school infrastructure and help the institution move closer to formal recognition under Tamil Nadu Matriculation norms.

This is not merely a construction activity. It is an important step in ensuring that highly vulnerable children receive the kind of education that genuinely prepares them for higher education, employment, confidence, and social mobility.

#### **Institutional Background and Educational Vision**

Human Uplift Trust was founded on the belief that **education is the strongest pathway out of poverty, stigma, and exclusion**. That belief is deeply tied to the founder's own life journey and has shaped the ethos of Vidyashram from the beginning. Vidyashram was established as a place of healing and hope for children who had lost parents to HIV, been abandoned by relatives, or experienced severe neglect and social rejection. Over the years, the campus has evolved into far more than a shelter: it has become a nurturing environment

where children receive care, discipline, emotional support, medical attention, and a chance to rebuild their lives.

At present, the institution provides a bridge between rescue and rehabilitation. But HUT now seeks to take the next crucial step: moving from a non-formal, Tamil-medium learning model toward a **structured English-medium school system** that gives children a level playing field. This transition is based not on aspiration alone, but on hard-earned experience. HUT has seen that many children who are bright, hardworking, and resilient still struggle after school because they lack English fluency, digital literacy, and exposure to modern educational resources.

The proposed school at Vidyashram is therefore rooted in a practical educational vision: to provide vulnerable children with not just schooling, but **quality schooling**—education that prepares them for college, careers, and dignified participation in society.

### **Why This Initiative Is Needed**

Perambalur is an educationally underserved rural district where access to quality schooling remains limited, especially for children from HIV-affected households, Dalit communities, and economically distressed families. The proposal makes clear that these children face multiple and overlapping disadvantages: stigma, disrupted family life, weak early schooling, poor access to English-medium education, lack of digital tools, and limited academic support. Many also require emotional healing, health monitoring, and safe learning environments—needs that ordinary rural schools are often not equipped to address.

For the children at Vidyashram, these challenges are even more severe. Many arrive after already dropping out of school. Some come with trauma, fear, illness, and low self-confidence. While Vidyashram has worked hard to provide continuity through non-formal education, HUT has recognized that this alone is not enough to secure long-term educational success.

A powerful example in the proposal is the story of **Ranjith**, a child who came to Vidyashram after extreme hardship, studied well, achieved excellent marks, and entered college, only to later discontinue his higher education because he could not cope with the English-language demands. His story became a turning point for the Vidyashram team. It showed that even highly capable children can lose life-changing opportunities when they do not receive strong foundational English-medium education from the beginning.

This realization lies at the heart of the present initiative. The need is not only to educate children, but to educate them in a way that equips them for the realities of higher education and employment. The proposed English-medium school is intended to prevent future generations of children from facing the same barriers.

### **Present Status and Infrastructure Gap**

Vidyashram already has important foundational assets in place. HUT owns **one acre of land** registered in the trust's name. The campus currently includes residential blocks, a health

centre, a dining shed, and some classroom infrastructure. In 2009, a primary school block with two classrooms and four toilets was constructed. In 2022, with support from **Asha for Education**, two additional first-floor classrooms were built. In 2024–25, funding from **GIC Re** supported the construction of **nine more classrooms and related academic facilities** (under construction)

Even with this progress, the school infrastructure remains incomplete. According to the proposal, Vidyashram ultimately needs to complete **14 classrooms** along with supporting facilities such as toilets, library, computer lab, staff rooms, administrative rooms, laboratories, and child-friendly academic spaces in order to meet the requirements for recognition under the Tamil Nadu English-medium school framework. At this stage, support is needed for **one more classroom**, which forms part of the final push toward completing the physical requirements of the school.

This means the current request is both strategic and practical. It does not stand in isolation; it completes a key missing component in a larger, well-progressed institutional plan.

### **Proposed Intervention**

The immediate proposal to Asha for Education is to support the **construction of one classroom with the required furniture** as part of the emerging English-medium school campus. This classroom will contribute directly to the completion of the larger school structure and help HUT move toward formal school recognition and full academic functioning.

Within the broader school-development plan, the campus is envisioned to include:

- safe classrooms built to required standards
- sanitation facilities
- science and computer laboratories
- digital learning spaces and smart classrooms
- RO drinking water and utility systems
- solar-powered support systems
- child-friendly interiors and safety systems
- future vocational and skill-building spaces.

The project is therefore not only about adding one room. It is about building a complete and inclusive educational environment where vulnerable children can study without fear, stigma, or deprivation. The proposal also emphasizes that the learning model will combine **English-medium instruction, digital literacy, foundational STEM exposure, psychosocial support, and gender-sensitive educational access**, especially for girls and first-generation learners.

## **Educational and Social Significance**

The proposed school is important because it responds directly to the lived realities of the children it serves. For HIV-affected and socially disadvantaged children, education is closely linked with safety, identity, confidence, and future independence. A formal English-medium school within Vidyashram would provide continuity of care while also improving academic standards, communication skills, digital readiness, and opportunities for higher education.

The proposal clearly links English-medium education with long-term opportunity. English proficiency expands access to better textbooks, online learning platforms, college education, scholarships, and employment pathways. Digital literacy is equally essential, especially in a context where rural children are often cut off from technology. By integrating both, Vidyashram seeks to ensure that its children are not left behind in a world increasingly shaped by communication skills and digital access.

The social significance is equally strong. The school would provide a **stigma-free educational ecosystem** for children who have often been rejected or marginalized in mainstream settings. It would combine education with healthcare access, emotional support, and a nurturing environment—making it a more holistic response than a conventional school alone.

## **Expected Outcomes**

The project is expected to generate both immediate and long-term benefits. In the short term, it will help strengthen the educational infrastructure needed for a formal school environment and bring Vidyashram closer to recognition under the state framework. It will improve classroom availability, reduce constraints on learning space, and support better academic organization.

In the medium term, the initiative will support:

- improved access to quality English-medium education for **85 resident children**
- stronger digital literacy and academic confidence
- improved student retention and reduced dropout risk
- a safer and more child-sensitive learning environment
- better readiness for formal schooling, examinations, and higher studies.

The proposal also anticipates broader community benefit. Over the next five years, the school is expected to extend its reach to **hundreds of additional children from nearby rural villages**, thereby creating a wider educational impact beyond the residential beneficiaries alone.

In the long term, the initiative aims to create a generation of children who are not only sheltered and educated, but also **confident, employable, and socially integrated**. It represents an effort to break the intergenerational cycle of poverty, educational disadvantage, and exclusion.

## **Sustainability and Institutional Credibility**

One of the strengths of this proposal is that it comes from an institution with an established track record. HUT has been working with vulnerable children for nearly two decades and has built community trust through direct service, transparent governance, and sustained commitment. Vidyashram is already functioning as a live institution—not a new concept on paper—and the proposed school is an expansion of this existing work.

The proposal also presents sustainability in several dimensions. Institutionally, HUT plans to continue supporting the school through a mix of partnerships, community support, alumni engagement, and long-term funding relationships. Educationally, once infrastructure is completed, the upgraded classrooms and academic spaces will continue serving children year after year. Economically, features such as solar systems, efficient utilities, and responsible planning are expected to reduce operating burdens over time. Socially, the project builds resilience by strengthening children's confidence, teacher capacity, and community awareness.

Importantly, Asha for Education is not a new supporter in this journey. The proposal recognizes Asha as a **longstanding partner** that has supported Vidyashram for many years, including earlier educational expenses and classroom development. The present request therefore builds on an existing relationship of trust and shared commitment to the education of underprivileged children.

## **Why This Support Matters at This Stage**

The present request is significant because Vidyashram is at a decisive stage of institutional growth. The foundation has already been laid through years of care work, prior infrastructure development, and continuing partnerships. What is now needed is targeted support to help complete the school structure and ensure that the educational vision becomes fully operational.

Support for one classroom may appear modest in isolation, but within the context of the overall school plan, it plays a crucial role. It contributes to the completion of the required infrastructure, advances the goal of formal recognition, and helps transform Vidyashram from a non-formal bridge-learning space into a structured English-medium educational institution for children who have already overcome immense adversity.

This support would therefore not simply create a physical asset. It would help remove a structural barrier standing between vulnerable children and a more dignified educational future.

## **Conclusion**

The Vidyashram initiative represents a thoughtful and deeply needed effort to strengthen education for children who have been affected by HIV, poverty, caste discrimination, abandonment, and educational exclusion. The proposal is grounded in lived experience,

institutional credibility, and a clear understanding of what vulnerable children need in order to succeed—not only shelter and basic schooling, but quality English-medium education, safe learning environments, digital access, and long-term support.

The requested support from **Asha for Education** for the construction of one classroom is part of a larger and meaningful educational transformation already underway at Vidyashram. By supporting this next step, Asha would help strengthen an institution that has already changed many lives and is now working to ensure that future generations of children do not lose opportunities because of the circumstances into which they were born.

At its core, this is an investment in educational justice: helping some of the most vulnerable children in rural Tamil Nadu move from survival to stability, and from stability to genuine opportunity.

## Project in detail

### **Empowering Futures: Community-Based Education Support for HIV-Affected and Socially Disadvantaged Children in Perambalur.**

#### **1. Executive Summary**

This proposal seeks one-time support from **Asha for Education – Silicon Valley Chapter** to strengthen educational opportunities and learning support systems for HIV-affected and socially disadvantaged children at the Vidyashram campus in Perambalur district, Tamil Nadu.

Perambalur is an educationally underserved rural district with limited access to quality English-medium schooling and modern learning infrastructure, particularly for children affected by HIV, caste marginalization, and extreme poverty. The proposed initiative aims to establish a fully equipped English-medium school with safe classrooms, laboratories, sanitation facilities, digital learning systems, and supportive educational environments that enable vulnerable children to access equitable, future-ready education.

The aim of the proposed initiative is to strengthen access to quality education for vulnerable children through improved learning resources, digital learning support, teacher mentoring, and safe learning spaces within the Vidyashram campus. The program will focus on improving English language proficiency, digital literacy, and academic confidence among children who face severe social stigma and economic disadvantage.

**The support from Asha will contribute toward the construction of one classroom** that will form part of the larger school campus being developed to ensure that vulnerable children receive quality education and opportunities for a dignified future. The project aligns with the mission of **Asha for Education to support grassroots initiatives that expand educational opportunities for underprivileged children in India.**



Human Uplift Trust (HUT- the non-profit) currently runs Vidyashram, a residential care and non-formal learning centre serving 85 HIV-affected and socially disadvantaged children. The campus possesses basic residential facilities and partially developed educational infrastructure but requires additional classrooms, toilet blocks, laboratories, and academic facilities to meet Tamil Nadu Matriculation School (primary and Nursery) recognition norms and deliver structured English-medium education.

For this we need to **complete 14 classrooms, toilet facilities and essential academic/digital infrastructure**, thereby enabling formal recognition, improving learning conditions and ensuring inclusive, gender-sensitive and stigma-free education for HIV-affected and socially disadvantaged children.

## Introduction

At Vidyashram, our primary goal is to provide children affected by HIV (mainly Dalit children) with the best possible opportunities for growth, development, and a brighter future. Currently, the children at our children's home are enrolled in a Tamil medium non formal school, where they receive their education in their native language. While this has been beneficial in fostering a strong foundation in their mother tongue, there is a growing need to introduce English medium education to better prepare them for the future and introduce a proper system of education. Currently the system is more like a bridge course.

## Project Presentation

### History of the Project: Story of a kid in our Children home-Vidyashram

"It was very difficult to cope without food especially during the rain and summer. Being on the street without a single blanket was a terrible way to live. I lost my father and mother to

a terrible disease" says seven-year-old Logesh in a feeble little voice. He is one of the 85 children adopted by Dr Raja in his children's home "Vidyashram" at Perambalur. Logesh was diagnosed to be HIV positive when he was born. He lost his mother and father to HIV. His experience of loss during his childhood has resulted in him becoming

extremely upset, insecure and afraid if he believes someone will leave his life.

While Human Uplift Trust (HUT) is founded in 1987, the children's home Vidyashram is 18-year-old and founded by the prominent diabetologist, Dr Raja Venkatesh and his wife Dr Indhra, and they house HIV positive children and children orphaned by HIV. It is now a place of healing and hope for children who have suffered abuse, neglect and maltreatment.

**"I believe that every child where ever born, where ever lives, should have the opportunity to grow in a safe and nurturing environment, have access to a good education to become a productive citizen of the country."** Dr. Venkatesh says.

He continues "I was born and brought up in a small village. The village had no transport till I reached class five. As a small boy, I made up my mind to find my way to medicine. I worked sincerely hard till I became the topper in my school and went on to the top Medical University with merits as one of the district toppers. So, I strongly believe education is the most powerful weapon which you can use to change your life..... and the world. Good education will create great opportunities for you"



In 2007, Dr Venkatesh's life changed when he adopted two HIV children of a patient who died in is hospital and founded this 'Vidyashram-Vidyashram' - a safe haven for the HIV-

infected and orphaned children. In the same year, he along with a team of like-minded committed volunteers identified nearly 39 similar children. In 2025 there are 85 such children who are now in his care.

For the past 18 years, Dr Raja's mission is to provide these AIDS infected/orphaned homeless children with safety, love, reassurance, a good educational opportunity ...and a hug when needed. His main objective is to rescue and provide shelter to the homeless HIV orphaned children who have been ostracized by their own relatives and live on streets.

His shelter provides these homeless children with all their basic requirements like beds, blankets, daily nutritional meals and snacks; served piping hot with a smile, clean clothing, education with a non-formal schooling in the campus, medical checkups, psychological support, bereavement counseling and large doses of individual attention; to make each feel special, to keep up their health.



Dr Raja and his wife donate half of their clinic income to these children. The founders, along with partners like Asha for education (SV), CSR support, community volunteers and well-wishers, continue to support the children through personal contributions and community engagement.

### **Founder's Vision & Inspiration**

HUT was founded by a survivor of deep personal hardship who understood firsthand the transformative power of education. Coming from a background marked by poverty and social vulnerability, he experienced how a single opportunity in education could redefine a life. This lived experience shaped his lifelong commitment to ensuring that no child—especially those stigmatized due to HIV or caste marginalization—should ever be denied dignity, hope, or opportunity.

The founder's conviction that "education is liberation" resonates strongly with the philosophy of organizations that support inclusive education for marginalized communities. The proposed school development at Vidyashram is therefore not merely a construction effort but an investment in the long-term educational empowerment of vulnerable children.

Human Uplift Trust (HUT) was established with a singular conviction—that education is the most powerful instrument to break the cycles of poverty, stigma, and social exclusion faced by HIV-affected children in rural Tamil Nadu. For nearly two decades, HUT has worked at the intersection of **education, health, child protection, psychosocial support, and rural community empowerment**, serving as a lifeline for orphaned and vulnerable children.

Over the years, HUT has earned the trust of local communities, district administration, and partner institutions due to its transparent governance, child-centric values, and evidence-based approach. Its long-standing vision is to create opportunities for marginalized children

that allow them to grow into healthy, confident, employable, and socially integrated young adults.

The proposed English-medium school at Vidyashram Campus is an extension of this commitment—built on the belief that every child, regardless of background, deserves equal access to quality education and a dignified future.

### **Case Study: From the Streets to a Dream Interrupted**

Ranjith came to Vidyashram as a frightened six-year-old boy. His father had died of AIDS and his mother, also battling the illness, could no longer care for him and his younger brother. With no relatives willing to take responsibility, the two boys were left to survive on the streets of a small village near Ariyalur.

Life was harsh and uncertain. Ranjith remembers those days vividly: selling fish to earn a few rupees, sharing a single meal with his brother, and spending cold nights without shelter. School was never even a possibility. Survival was the only concern.

When the brothers were brought to Vidyashram, their lives slowly began to change. For the first time, they experienced safety, love, regular meals, medical care, and the opportunity to study. At Vidyashram, Ranjith began his schooling and quickly showed remarkable academic ability. With the support and encouragement of the teachers and caregivers, he worked hard and steadily regained confidence.

Ranjith proved to be an exceptionally bright student. He developed a strong interest in mathematics and science and consistently performed well in school. In his higher secondary examinations, he secured excellent marks and even achieved a **school rank**, a remarkable achievement for a child who had once lived on the streets. With great hope and determination, he gained admission to a reputed college for higher education in Trichy.



However, the transition to college brought an unexpected challenge. Like many children from disadvantaged backgrounds, Ranjith had studied entirely in Tamil medium during his early schooling. When he entered college, where instruction and academic materials were

largely in English, he struggled to cope with the language barrier. Despite his intelligence and hard work, the lack of a strong English foundation made it extremely difficult for him to continue. Eventually, overwhelmed by the language gap, Ranjith had to discontinue his college education. Today, he works in a small supermarket, earning a modest income.

Ranjith's story is both inspiring and deeply painful. It shows how a child rescued from extreme poverty and capable of academic excellence can still lose opportunities due to gaps in foundational education.

For the team at Vidyashram, Ranjith's experience became a powerful turning point. It made us realize that while providing education is essential, **equipping children with strong English-medium and communication skills from the early years is equally critical** for their success in higher education and employment.

This realization played a key role in our decision to establish an **English-medium school at Vidyashram**, so that children growing up in our care will not face the same barriers in the future. Through this initiative, we hope that the next generation of children will not only dream of a better life—but will also have the tools and opportunities to achieve it.

### **Background of the present construction project**

The life of a child or an adult who became HIV positive is unimaginably stressful and challenging. Children will be left homeless, grappling for food and shelter and under these extraordinary circumstances, they could only imagine, what getting educated means! 'HUT's Vidyashram AIDS orphans' project' is an integrated learning center for the HIV infected and orphaned (CIA and CAA) children with a special focus on Dalit Children. At present 85 children are in the home and school. About 70% of them are from the Dalit community. Vidyashram provides comprehensive educational, emotional, nutritional and medical care to the HIV orphaned and vulnerable children through a home and a non-formal school inside the campus.

Vidyashram home provides free accommodation, clothes, food and medicines to the children. The goal is also to help them with psychological support, to rebuild their self-confidence and nurture values that will significantly increase their chances of reaching a better adulthood.

VIDYASHRAM is also offering the children with an in-campus clinic situated in the campus for the early identification and treatment of opportunistic infections during the course of HIV. Children are provided anti-retro viral treatment and treatment for tuberculosis if identified with a low immune level by affiliation with the local government hospitals.

All the children arriving at Vidyashram have discontinued school already. It is therefore essential to offer them refresher courses in order to bring them up to the standard level.

To reach this goal, HUT has founded a non-formal school in 2007 inside the facilities of the children's home. The Vidyashram school was started with the the ultimate objective to improve the quality of life of the children by providing basic education. The model focuses on (i) acquisition of basic reading, writing and numeric skills, (ii) imbibing a sound value system, (iii) physical fitness and preparing for higher education.

Presently we have one acre land (registered in the name of the trust), 2 blocks (12,000) sq ft area for children accommodation (boys/girls dormitories and health centre), 4 classrooms,

and 9 classrooms under construction -project sanctioned by GIC Re CSR fund. We have a separate shed for the dining space.

## The need for English Medium Education

The introduction of English-medium education will be complemented by technology-enabled learning, smart classrooms, and digital literacy. This combined approach will equip children with the communication and technological skills required to pursue higher education and meaningful employment opportunities.

Over these 17 years Vidyashram has produced more than 250 graduates; a part of them with an under graduate degree and the remaining with enough education to find a job. How ever we have learnt over time that the children face serious difficulties when they the enter the job market after their schooling because they had their entire education only in Tamil (their mother tongue) and didn't have an opportunity to learn, read or speak English well. **This has compelled some of them to take up a menial daily labor job which is the only available option for survival.** Hence, we strongly feel that, to compete in a level playing field with the other children, we need to incorporate English medium education and computer literacy in the school.

### 1. Global Opportunities:

English is widely regarded as the global language of communication, business, and technology. By providing English medium education, we equip our children with the skills they need to succeed on an international stage.

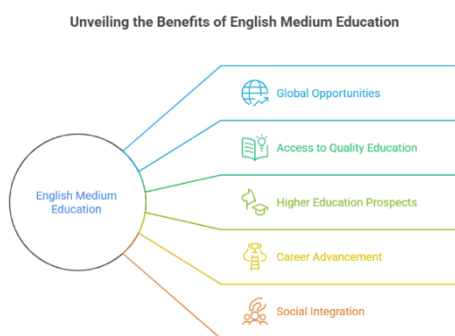
### 2. Access to Quality Education:

By introducing English medium education, we can give our children access to a broader range of high-quality educational materials. This will enhance their learning experience and enable them to explore subjects in greater depth.

### 3. Higher Education Prospects:

English is often the medium of instruction in universities and colleges across India and abroad. By familiarizing children with English from an early age, we prepare them for the demands of higher education. This foundation will make it easier for them to pursue

specialized courses, scholarships, and study abroad opportunities that require proficiency in English.



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### 4. Career Advancement:

In today's competitive job market, fluency in English is a valuable asset. Many employers prefer candidates who can communicate effectively in English, especially in fields such as IT, healthcare, engineering, and management. By offering English

medium education, we enhance our children's employability and help them secure better career opportunities in the future.

### 5. Social Integration:

English is not only a language of education and work but also a bridge for social integration. In a diverse country like India, where people from different linguistic backgrounds interact, English serves as a common language. Proficiency in English enables our children to communicate and connect with people beyond their immediate community, fostering social mobility and inclusion.

### Problem statement

Perambalur district ranks among Tamil Nadu's most educationally and socially vulnerable regions. The challenges faced by HIV-affected and Dalit communities include:

- **High levels of stigma and exclusion**, particularly for children from HIV-affected households
- **Poor access to quality education** in rural belts, especially English-medium schooling
- **Limited infrastructure** for science education, digital literacy, and skill development
- **High dropout rates** among vulnerable children due to economic stress and discrimination
- **Insufficient support systems** for mental health, nutrition, and preventive care

For the 85 children at HUT's Vidyashram, these disadvantages are multiplied. Many arrive with histories of abandonment, trauma, disrupted schooling, and severe health vulnerabilities.

The district has few institutions that offer:

- good English medium education at affordable or free cost
- child-friendly classrooms,
- integrated health–education support,
- psychosocial care,
- equal opportunities for marginalized groups,
- and future-ready skill exposure.

These challenges reflect the broader gaps in rural educational infrastructure and inclusive learning access in underserved districts of India. HIV-affected and socially disadvantaged children face compounded vulnerabilities of stigma, disrupted schooling, poor health, and economic deprivation.

Establishing an integrated English-medium educational facility with safe classrooms, sanitation, laboratories, and digital learning systems directly addresses these structural barriers and contributes to rural community development and human capability enhancement—key priorities within the funding framework of Asha for Education.

The digital divide in rural Perambalur further deepens the disadvantage faced by children from vulnerable backgrounds. Providing access to computers, digital learning tools, and

English-medium education will help bridge this gap and enable these children to compete with students from better-resourced schools.

### **Where we stand now in addressing the challenges**

Over the years, HUT has gradually developed basic educational facilities within the Vidyashram campus. However, additional learning resources, improved classroom environments, and digital education tools are required to ensure that children receive quality education comparable to mainstream schools. In 2009, HUT has constructed a schooling block (especially for the primary school age group Class 1-4/age 6-9). The block consists of two classrooms of size (20 ft x20 ft) according to government guidelines and four toilets.

**In 2022 with ASHA For Education funding, we built two more classrooms in the first floor. This year 2024-25, we got funding from GIC Re CSR fund to the tune of 1.63 crores for the construction of 9 additional classrooms and other facilities like libraries, lab, computers etc.,**

As on date, we need to construct a total of 14 classrooms to get the recognition from the Primary school education department, Tamil Nadu, under the Primary English medium schools' requirement for a high school. It requires certain standards of construction, certain number of classrooms and additional features like the Library, Computer lab, staff rooms, administrative rooms etc.,

### **Solution: Strengthening Rural Educational Infrastructure**

To address these challenges, the project proposes the development of additional classrooms, sanitation facilities, laboratories, and technology-enabled learning spaces within the Vidyashram campus. The intervention creates a comprehensive rural educational infrastructure that improves access, quality, safety, and inclusiveness in schooling for vulnerable children.

The proposed components totally include:

- Construction of classrooms meeting state educational standards
- Development of gender-sensitive sanitation facilities
- Establishment of science and computer laboratories
- Creation of digital learning and smart classroom environments
- Provision of safe water, solar power, and campus utilities
- Child-friendly, inclusive learning spaces

### **Construction of Additional Classrooms:**

- On a whole the most effective solution is to construct 10 additional classrooms (out of which we got funding for 9 and need one more) and a toilet block. By adding this only we can complete the construction of the whole school and get the recognition from the TN Matriculation English medium board.
- We can reduce the student-to-teacher ratio, allowing for smaller, more manageable class sizes as per the government standard.

## Project Objectives

### Broad Objectives

- To provide equitable, high-quality English-medium and technology-enabled education to HIV-affected and disadvantaged children in Perambalur.
- To integrate digital learning tools, computer literacy, and foundational STEM exposure for rural children.
- To offer a safe, inclusive, gender-sensitive learning environment that promotes dignity, confidence, and long-term capability building.
- To improve educational continuity, employability, and upward mobility for children who face extreme social, economic, and health vulnerabilities.
- To strengthen community resilience by reducing stigma, increasing awareness, and supporting children's holistic development.

Collectively, these objectives contribute to improving rural educational infrastructure, expanding access to quality learning opportunities, and strengthening long-term social mobility for vulnerable children in underserved regions—areas strongly aligned with the priorities of Asha for Education.

### Specific Objectives

The following specific objectives directly contribute to the broader Asha for Education's aligned goals outlined above:

The specific objectives of this project are:

- To construct one classroom (Nine more classrooms under construction) with the required furniture.
- To help the school obtain official recognition under the Tamil Nadu Matriculation English Medium Board.
- To reduce the student-teacher ratio, thereby enhancing the quality of education.
- To provide a safe, inclusive, and child-friendly learning environment.
- To ensure digital readiness among students through computer education, online learning modules, and Asha for Education-supported technology solutions.
- To provide special support for girl children, ensuring equitable access to education and opportunities, consistent with Asha for Education's emphasis on gender equality.

### Alignment with Asha for Education Mission

The proposed project aligns with the mission of Asha for Education to support grassroots initiatives that expand access to quality education for underprivileged children in India. Vidyashram serves children affected by HIV, poverty, and social stigma due to caste, many of whom have experienced disrupted schooling. By strengthening the school infrastructure and learning environment, the project contributes to providing these children with stable educational opportunities and a pathway toward a dignified and independent future.

### Beneficiaries

The project will directly benefit **85 HIV-affected children (25 HIV-positive and 60 from HIV-affected families) and 500 more children from the nearby rural villages in the next**

**five years reach.** This aligns with Asha for Education’s mission of supporting underserved, socially backward, and vulnerable children through education and digital access.

### **Project Scope and Key Activities**

The project covers the construction of additional classrooms, a toilet block and laboratories for science, art and computer education; installation of solar-powered lighting and water conservation systems; provision of RO drinking water; and greening of the campus with environmentally responsible landscaping. The initiative also includes setting up child-friendly interiors, essential utilities, digital teaching tools and safety systems. A future-ready vocational wing will be developed to support practical skill-building in line with community needs.

### **Implementation Plan:**

The implementation will follow a phased, transparent, and community-integrated approach, aligned with established project management and transparency standards followed by Asha for Education.

#### **Phase 1: Infrastructure Development (Months 1–9) Startin April 2026**

- Construction of **ten RCC classrooms** adhering to child safety & structural standards
- Electrical, plumbing, ventilation, natural lighting & safety installations
- Establishment of science laboratories, computer lab, and art room
- Procurement and installation of furniture, digital learning equipment, and safety systems

**Compliance:** All construction will adopt environmentally responsible practices per Asha for Education’s guidelines.

#### **Phase 2: Academic and Operational Strengthening (Months 10–12)**

- Recruitment of qualified teachers
- Development of subject-wise lesson plans for STEM, arts, and digital literacy
- Teacher training on child psychology and inclusive classrooms
- Integration of smart learning modules
- Teacher development will include digital pedagogy, use of smart classrooms, and technology-assisted teaching, supporting Asha for Education’s goal of building 21st-century learning environments.
- Apply for the recognition from the Tamil Nadu government and start the school by June 2027.

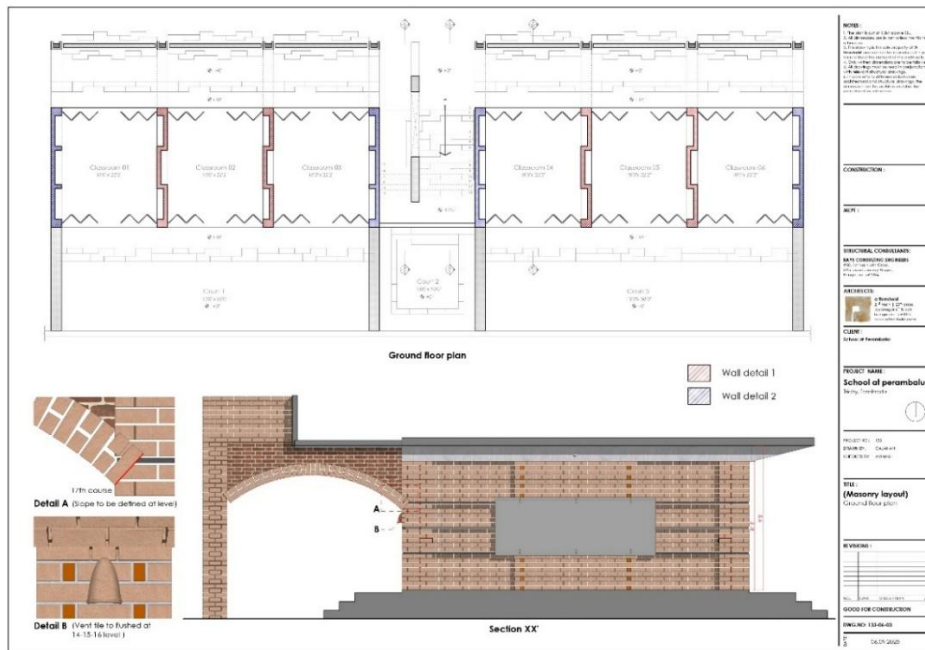

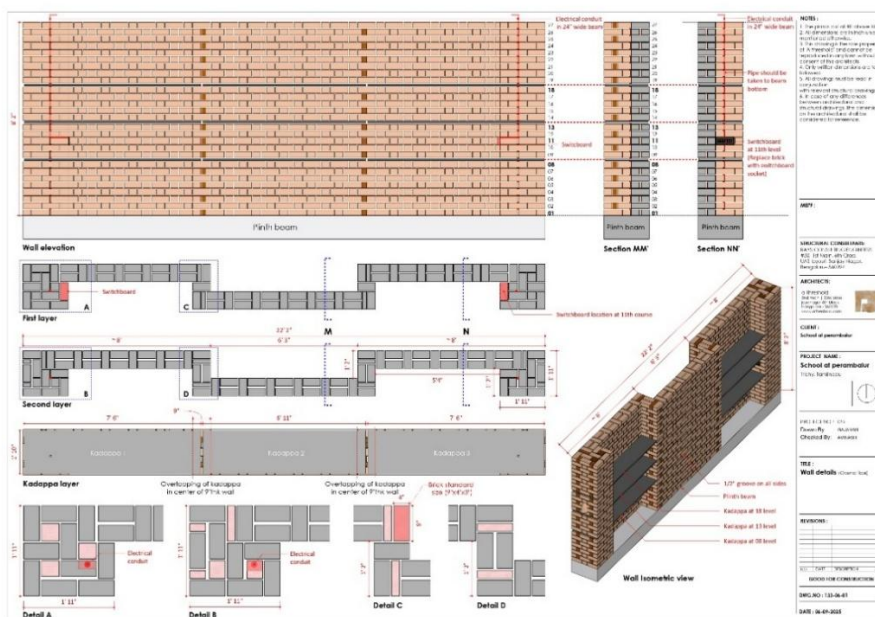

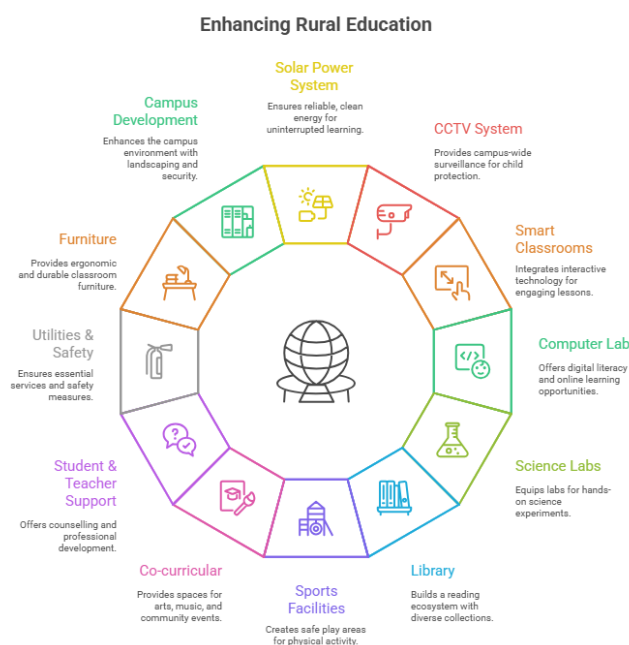

Solar energy systems, rainwater harvesting structures, natural lighting and ventilation, and environmentally responsible materials will significantly reduce operational costs and carbon footprint. The school will follow a strong maintenance and upkeep plan to ensure prolonged durability of the constructed spaces. The vocational training component will help build long-term livelihoods for older students and local youth. The combination of educational empowerment, community engagement and environmental protection ensures lasting impact, in line with Asha for Education's sustainability framework.

The project incorporates multiple layers of sustainability:

#### 1. Institutional Sustainability

HUT has operated successfully for nearly 20 years and will continue to sustain the school through **a diversified funding model that includes CSR partnerships, community participation, alumni networks, and ongoing collaborations with national and international development organizations**. This ensures the school's long-term operational and financial stability.

#### 2. Educational Sustainability

The upgraded infrastructure — including laboratories, digital learning spaces, and well-structured classrooms — allows the curriculum to be strengthened permanently. This ensures improved learning outcomes, higher retention, lower dropout rates, and better readiness for higher education, fully reflecting Asha for Education's "Education for All" mission.

#### 3. Social Sustainability

- Reduced dropout rates and increased transition to higher secondary education.

### Indirect Impact

- Over **350+ rural families** will benefit through improved community awareness, reduced stigma, and greater educational access.
- Regional socio-economic upliftment through skill-building and future employability.
- Strengthened rural education ecosystem in Perambalur, contributing to long-term community resilience.

- Creation of a model institution demonstrating successful rehabilitation and empowerment of HIV-affected children and impoverished dalit children.

### **Fund management**

A legal agreement contract would be executed with the contracting firm by HUT, which ensures the quality of construction, fund utilization, time duration of the work completion, post completion technical assistance and a valuation and quality check up by a government (not less than the rank of an assistant engineer) chartered engineer at the completion of construction. Fund payment dates to the firm are also listed in the agreement in installments based on the level of completion. Only account payee cheques would be given to ensure good accounting practices. A three-quote system for procuring goods as per the financial guidelines of HUT would be ensured.

### **Stakeholder involvement and monitoring**

Various stakeholders including the consultants, technical consultants, community beneficiaries and board members of HUT will make frequent monitoring visits to check the quality and status of construction. Board members from HUT, the director of HUT, the project manager of HUT will make a visit multiple times a week. HUT would welcome the visit from the agency to visit the project at any point of time.

### **Conclusion – A Sustainable Step Towards Inclusive Education**

This proposal represents a continued effort by Human Uplift Trust to provide vulnerable children with access to quality education and a supportive learning environment. Support for the development of classroom infrastructure will help ensure that HIV-affected and socially disadvantaged children in rural Tamil Nadu can study in safe and well-equipped educational spaces.

Through integrated infrastructure development, inclusive education, and community engagement, the project will establish Vidyashram as a model rural educational campus—demonstrating how support in education infrastructure can generate lasting social impact for vulnerable communities.

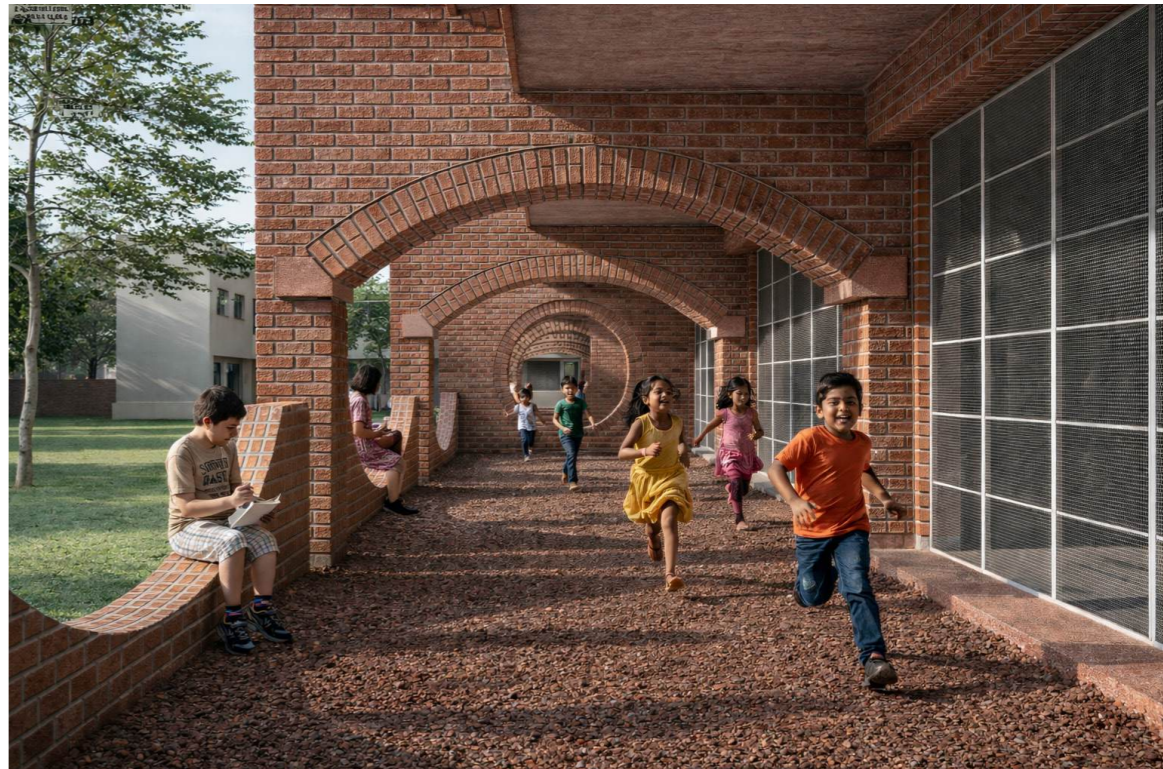

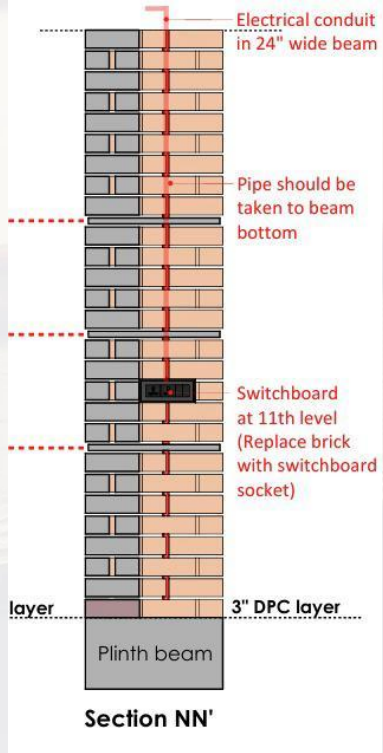

AND WHEREAS prior to the execution of these presents the DONOR has handed over to the Trustees a sum of Rs.500/- (the receipt whereof the Trustees do hereby admit and acknowledge)

AND WHEREAS Donor and the Trustees are now desirous of declaring the Trust and of executing this Deed concerning the said sum of Rs.500/- and the said project.

NOW THEREFORE THIS DEED OF TRUST WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

(1) This Trust shall be called as "Human uplift Trust" (hereinafter called "HUT")

The primary objects of the Trust shall be "Rural development".

This includes:

1. (a) Formal, Technical and Awareness Education and skills development for the rural folk.
- (b) Rural technologies (Agricultural, agro-industrial and appropriate technology)
- (c) Youth and women leadership formation

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(d) Health and sanitation (under comprehensive rural health services)

2. Building Low cost houses for village communities with a community dimension.
3. To initiate and promote cooperation among individuals organisation and Government agencies having similar objectives.
4. To help children, women, aged and the handicapped village folk through economic and soecial welfare programmes of social welfare board.
5. To take up any other development activity which is in line with the central theme of "Rural Development".

3. This office of the Trust shall be situtated at present at Gandhinagar, Melasridevimangalam Village, Mannachanallur Block, Lalgudi Taluk, Trichy District or at such other place in India as the Trustees may decide upon.

Branch offices of the Trust if deemed necessary shall be opened at the discretion of the Trustees at one or more places in India.

4. The Trustees shall hold the sum of Rs.500/- and all other funds, monyes and property which may be received by them or secure to the Trust hereafter either by way of donations,

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subscriptions, gifts, or income, rent, interest dividends or otherwise howsoever and all investments representing the same (all of which are hereafter referred as the "Trust Fund") on Trust and subject to the powers, provisions, agreement and declarations hereinafter declared and contained concerning the same.

5. The Trustees shall get in and collect the income, interest and dividends of the "Trust Fund" from time to time and shall there from pay in the first instance all the costs charges and expenses of and shall hold the net balance of the income and the corpus of the trust Fund for the objects of the Trust herebefore mentioned.

6. For the Purpose of carrying out the objects of the Trust and for providing the facilities and undertaking the activities as mentioned above the Trustee shall be entitled to Utilise the funds or Trust as well as its income in such a manner as they shall in their prudence and Judicious discretion deem it proper.

7. The Trustees shall be entitled to receive upon such terms and conditions as they may deem fit, donations, gifts Subscriptions in cash or in kind and to collect funds by public

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or private appeal for carrying out the objects of the Trust.

8. For the purpose of carrying out the objects of the Trust, the Trustees shall be entitled to purchase and/or to construct one or more building or buildings and to purchase other immoveable property or properties suitable for the functioning of the project. The Trustees shall also be entitled to purchase or acquire furniture equipment and all other moveable property as may be necessary or proper for maintaining and conducting the project and for providing the facilities and undertaking the activities at such places as may be decided upon and otherwise to give effect to the objects of the trust.

9. The Trustees shall invest the Trust Fund and its income as may be required or necessary for the purpose of, carrying out the objects of the Trust in immoveable properties, shares, or debentures of Government controlled companies, Government securities, deposits in Scheduled Banks or limited companies with power to the Trustees to vary such investments from time to time into other or others of the same nature.

10. The Trustees shall be entitled to sell by public auction or by private treaty as they may deem proper any immoveable

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properties forming part of the Trust upon such terms and conditions as they may deem proper and beneficial to the Trust.

11. The Trustees shall have power to raise loans or obtain advance for the purpose of the Trust with or without security and upon such terms and conditions as they deem proper.

12. The Trustees shall be entitled to let out its building or portions thereof as is not required for the purpose of the Trust and also other immoveable properties which form part of the Trust on such terms and conditions as they deem proper.

13. The number of Trustees shall not be less than 3 (three) and more than 7 (Seven) provided however that if the number of Trustees became less than 3 (three) the surviving or the continuing of Trustees so as to bring the number of Trustees to the minimum as herein provided.

14. The Trustees shall be entitled to appoint one Trustee from amongst themselves as the Managing Trustee with such powers and for such period and upon such terms as the Trustees may from time to time decide. Apart from the Managing Trustee the Trustees shall be entitled to appoint another Trustee from amongst themselves as whole-Time Trustee. The Trustees appointed shall at all time during their period devote either on whole time or part time basis, to the various activities of the trust and for t

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services rendered they shall draw monthly allowances and other perquisites as the trustees time to time determined.

15. The Trustees shall be entitled to remove and replace any number of such advisory committees or reconstitute such committees from time to time.

16. Among the trustees one shall be financial Trustee for the first time or till the period he likes to continue to work in the Trust in the capacity for promoting the Finance of the Trust.

17. Every property of the Trust, movable or immovable shall be kept in the name of the trust.

18. The term of office of a Trustees shall not exceed three years from the date of his acceptance of the Trusteeship, provided however that he shall be eligible for re-appointment by the Trustees and the rights, powers and duties assigned to the existing Trustee or Trustees will also be vested in the Trustee or Trustees jointly and severally with the surviving or continuing Trustee or Trustees. Every new Trustee appointed as aforesaid shall have the same powers, authorities and discret and shall in all respects act as if he had been originally appointed trustee presents.

19. Whenever any Trustee resigns, dies or becomes insolvent or insane or is so convicted of a criminal offence

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involving moral turpitude or desires to be discharged from or refuses or becomes unfit or incapable of acting, then in every case, the surviving or the continuing Trustees will fill up the vacancy of Trustee in the place of such trustee becoming insolvent or being convicted.

20. Every resolution or decision of the Trustees, unless unanimous, shall be taken by a majority of the Trustees present and voting and in the case of equality of vote, the Managing Trustee or chairman of the meeting shall <sup>have</sup> be a casting vote. The Trustees may pass any resolution by circulation if it is unanimous.

21. The Trust shall be entitled to levy charge and collect such fees or subscriptions as they may from time to time decide for the facilities to be provided at which of its projects and for the use of and occupation of the rooms, auditorium, of any other part of its buildings.

22. The trustees shall be entitled to frame rules and regulations for the conduct of their business and for the administration of the Trust and for carrying out its objectives and for the maintenance and conduct of its project its activities and the facilities provided therein and to alter amend or vary such rules and regulations from time to time as they may deem proper. Such rules and regulations shall not be contravention of the provision of the Income tax Act in this respect.

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23. The Trustees may open an account or accounts with any one or more Scheduled Banks in the name of the Trust or such other trustees as may be authorised for the purpose by the Trustees for the time being with power in the Managing Trustee or Trustees appointed for the purpose to operate the same.

24. Proper accounts showing all receipts and disbursements made on account of the Trust hereby constituted shall be kept by the Trustees and the same shall be duly audited with all necessary vouchers at least once in every year by such auditor or auditors as the Trust appoints.

25. The Trustees shall have full power to compromise or compound all actions/suits and proceedings and all differences and demands and to refer any dispute or differences in arbitration and to adjust, settle and approve all accounts relating to the Trust funds.

26. The Trustees shall be entitled to engage such staff and servants and upon such terms as to remunerations and to their connected matters as they may deem proper and to suspend, remove and dismiss any persons as employed and make provisions for the benefit of the staff by way of provident fund, gratuity or otherwise as the Trustees may deem proper.

27. The receipt by the Managing Trustee or any other persons

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duly authorised by the Trustees for the money paid in respect of Trust fund or in respect of any money which any otherwise become payable in the Trust or in respect of the Trust shall effectivly discharge the person or persons paying the same there from or from assessing to the application thereof.

28. The Trustees for the time being under these presents shall be respectively chargeable only such moneys as they shall respectively actually receive notwithstanding their respectively signing any receipt or receipts for the sake of conformity and shall be answerable and accountable for only their own acts, receipts, neglects or defaults and not for these or the others or other of them or of for any Banker or other person with whom or in whose hands any trust moneys & may be deposited or come or for any loss unless the same shall happen through their or his own wilful default.

29. The trustees or Trustee for the time being may reimburse themselves or himself or pay and discharge out of the Trust fund all expenses properly incurred in or about the execution of the Trust or powers under these presents.

30. It is hereby declared that no benefit accrued wh shall ensure either directly or indirectly to the Trustees.

31. The Trustees consider that the object of the Trust will be better achieved if the income tax on the Trust is exempted under

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the Income Tax Act. In case however, a particular clause of the instrument of Trust has been inadvertently clothed in language capable of an inter-pretation in conflict with the relevent provisions of the Income Tax Act granting exemptions, it is expressly declared that such clauses shall have restricted meaning or null and void so that the relevant Income Tax Act provisions will always have the over riding effect.
