## Site Visit of Pranabananda Boy's Hostel Done between January 31 and February 5<sup>th</sup> 2013 Manoj Bhattacharyya

Earlier this year, I had visited Pranabananda Boy's hostel several times. Asha-SV has been supporting this project for several years and the progress of this project has been very encouraging. The students who just a few short years ago could hardly speak the Bengali language, are now going to local high schools, performing cultural functions in the hostel campus, joining in annual sports, playing drum and overall looking quite healthy.

I went to the hostel by crossing a river, although a bridge now connects the two sides of Malda town quite easily. Every time I took the trip, I was inspired to see the energy of the students and the dedication of the teachers and overall liveliness of the hostel.



My interactions with the students were very informal. Students seemed to open up to me with ease. They readily posed for pictures. When I asked them whether they liked to stay at the hostel rather than going home to work in the farms or some other jobs, they were unequivocal in their answers that they liked staying in the hostel. The students were not any different from any other kids of their ages. They knew Hindi songs (some even sang some for me, although I was a little out-of-touch with the hit songs), and they all had dreams of becoming engineers, doctors and teachers.











During early January 2013, during a very popular religious celebration on campus (Saraswati Puja), the students performed cultural function. Although the celebration did not take place during the time I was there, the description and photos were very encouraging. The women teachers of the on-site primary school trained and even acted in some of the roles. Once again, following photos emphasize that these students are getting some of the benefits, albeit in a smaller scale, that our so called "privileged" class children get. To me, this was encouraging and gratifying.
