Poll - ASEEMA Cycle 4

Asha San Francisco's project Aseema has applied for its 4th annual round of funding for 2014-15.

Aseema's provides education to street and underprivileged children in and around the Mumbai area. Among its several initiatives, they operate two Rural Education Centers in Igatpuri (suburb of Mumbai). Asha SF funds one pre-primary class of ~35-40 children in the age group 3-6 years in one of these centers.

In the previous annual cycle (3rd), we funded them for a total amount of Rs 6,55,825

The current proposal raises a total budget of Rs. 8,93,104 (~\$14,500), which is a 36% increase. In line with our recent chapter decision to fund existing projects for no more than 20% increase over previous cycle, Aseema's total budget that we can consider is Rs 7,87,000.

In our recent meeting we discussed the latest proposal, site visit results etc. Please find these details on project page at http://www.ashanet.org/projects/project-view.php?p=855.

Aseema steward Sandeep Gandhi undertook a detailed evaluation of the project. His due diligence suggests that an 11% increase over previous cycle appears reasonable - a total amount of Rs 7,25,465. He also draws our attention to the insights of site visitor Reshma who physically reviewed the project site last month. Reshma's impression was that the total amount raised by the project is reasonable, given their program, quality and related costs to deliver (see site visit results at http://www.ashanet.org/projects-new/documents/855/Aseema%20Site%20Visit%20Feb% 2025%202014 with%20stewardSandeep%20inputs.pdf)

Sandeep's final recommendation is that the chapter should consider minimum 11% increase (Rs 7,25,465) and maximum 20% increase (Rs 7,87,000)
