The aims and objectives of the organisation are:

Uplift the condition of people living in Slums and remote villages by means of Education.

Conduct tuition classes and provide inspiration for Students to aspire for higher ambitions.

Create role models from impoverished areas. Morality and Mind Control training imparted. These role models are professionals and other graduates.

Form an organised youth group in Slums and remote villages. These youth groups will work for the Educational upliftment of the community.

These organised youth groups will spread their activities in other surrounding areas. Hence there will be a network of all young people who will work in a very constructive manner.

Carry the message that complete education is the be all and end all of life. This uplifts a person and makes him contribute to the society in a positive manner.

Our activities will channelise the entire community into being positive and constructive.

MOTHER is a non-religious, non-political organisation and hence doesn't have any affiliation with religious groups or political parties.

Morality and Mind Control training is provided to all the beneficieries. This is pivotal for the integrated development of the children.

MOTHER is involved in following non education-related activities.

- Conducting Health camps in our working areas.
- Organising Mobile Science Awareness camps covering a cluster of villages.
- Conducting Street Dramas to enhance awareness amongst parents.
 - Organizing Sports Activities for physical development.

MOTHER runs Education centres in Villages. The classes are conducted in the evenings. MOTHER supports Village schools by providing teachers. MOTHER also organises computer training for City Slum and Village children.

Academic Education with special care for failed students. Provide motivation, guidance and help for students with an aim to completely eliminate school drop-outs. Students are also enrolled in vocational training.courses.

- Through Morality and Meditation training the faculties of the students are enhanced.
- Visual based teaching with demonstrative kits, working models and other exhibits
- Complete simplification of Academic syllabus for 10th Std and 12th Std students.
- Mobile Science Exhibitions are organised to make students easily understand the concepts.
- Students are encouraged to organise Exhibitions on Science, Mathematics, Social Sciences etc.
 - Library is set-up for students to use their time in a constructive manner.

11. What is the literacy rate in the local community?

Literacy rate is marginally low in our target communities. Only about 10% would have completed 12th Std and about 1% would have gone to colleges.

12. Describe the socio-economic background of the children and their parents (e.g. education, occupational). If any of your students are employed, please tell us about that as well.

We are working with children whose parents are

- Daily wage/casual labouries, Servent maids, Conservancy workers
- Agricultural coolies/landless labourers.

All our students are first generation learners from their family. Their parents earn about 100-150 Rs a day. Casual labourers find some days without any job. In villages it is dependent on the agricultural season. All our students work during the vacations to earn some money for their family and pay some amount for their school fees. Some of our students work during night from 8:00PM to 11:00PM.

13. In addition to education, does your group provide any other services to the children in your schools (e.g. food, health care, clothing, etc.)?

MOTHER organisation provides following facilities to our students:

- Meditation Training is provided to the children which enhances the capabilities of the student.
- Provide food for students in dire need daily and for all students during their examinations studies.
- Provide Health tonics, medicines in periodic basis.
- Provide Educational materials like books, stationaries etc to all the students.
- Provide clothing for college going students.
 - Pay School fees/College fees for our students and volunteers.
