# 20th Annual General Meeting



## SECRETARY'S REPORT

Hon'ble President **Dr. S. N. Banerjee**, Esteemed Members of Kalyania, Distinguished guests, Ladies & Gentlemen, today 27th Oct. 2018, I welcome you all in the **20th Annual General Meeting** of Kalyania.

The survival of man and woman in the society as an individual depends much upon the cooperation and help of other human beings. Therefore, happiness of the individual forms the happiness of the society. Since welfare and happiness are inextricably intertwined, giving a helping hand to a needy one is not only a responsibility, but it also becomes an act of humanity for everyone. A little keenness or readiness to serve the underprivileged people enables us to attain such a level of joy and contentment that all other material comforts of life become insignificant. As Mark Twain said ***"To get the full value of joy and happiness you must have someone to divide it with"***.

It was on 1<sup>st</sup> of July, 1998, **KALYANIA** was born out of the determination, sweat and hard work of a small group of like-minded people who were passionately driven by the extraordinary dream to stand by the people ***"in need"***.

We, at Kalyania, initially started our social welfare services with Charitable Health Care for the aged and elderly people in and around Kalyani, enabling the senior citizens to live an active, dignified and healthier life. It is because of your blessings, good wishes and whole-hearted support that have been a major source of inspiration for Kalyania to overcome all challenges and forge ahead as a full-fledged social welfare service organization with the conviction of spreading its wings into other services in time to come. In one of his finest Hadith, Prophet Mohammad, while explaining ***"what is a noble work"*** said ***"Any work which brings happiness and smile to others, would always be remembered as a noble deed."***





**Kalyania** had a humble beginning with only **Healthcare** services for the senior citizens. Today, slowly but steadily we have stepped into other welfare services like running a **Primary School** for the underprivileged children of the vicinity, conducting co-curricular activities like **Drawing and Singing Classes, Recitation Classes, Story-telling Sessions** and also **Adult Education Program**. We also run **Sebika / Home Nursing Training Programs** for the economically backward rural women to provide them a dignified and convenient means of livelihood.

**Computer Training** is given to poor students for upgrading their skills for higher studies and employment. In order to motivate bright and deserving students from poor economic background to complete their Secondary and Higher education, Kalyania awards scholarships which have been generously donated and funded by many of our well-wishers. The aforementioned social welfare services have brought us very close to the heart of the people of Kalyani and its neighborhood.

As on date, the total number of Life Members of Kalyania is 374. Here, with profound grief and sorrow I regret to inform that during this year, we have lost some of our most vibrant life members, wellwishers and OAH inmates who left for their heavenly abode Narayan Goswami, Sabitri Mukherjee, Malay Basu and Subodh Chandra Roy. May god grant peace to their departed souls. But we always sense and feel their presence around us, in all our activities.

I take this opportunity to take you through some of the major social welfare projects that were successfully run and executed by **Kalyania** during the year.



## SALIENT FEATURES OF OUR ACTIVITIES



### 1. HEALTHCARE SERVICES

- ❑ **Late Suryya Kumar Roy Charitable Health Clinic** : Little children, women and the elderly people with very low income, living in remote and backward areas of Kalyani sub-division are given free medical treatment. Free healthcare service is also available to such people for treatment of critical diseases like **Epilepsy and Diabetes**.
- ❑ **Ambulance Services** in loving memory of Late Surya Kumar Roy.
- ❑ Organizing various **Health Awareness Programs**.
- ❑ Arranging **Health Check up Camps**.
- ❑ **Organizing Mental Health Counseling Programs** including treatment of mental disorders.

### 2. SERVICES FOR SENIOR CITIZEN

- ❑ Isolation and loneliness comes with old age. Old age is an unavoidable part of our life cycle and should be lived gracefully rather than grudgingly. Kalyania provides social security to the senior citizens by taking specialized care of their needs in a holistic manner, enabling them to live active, dignified and healthier lives. **Priyabala Chakrabarty Old-Age Home**, run by Kalyania, is an honest and sincere accomplishment of the project in this regard.
- ❑ About ageing, through one of his characters, Shakespeare said ***“With mirth and laughter let the old wrinkles come”***. (*Gratiano in Merchant of Venice*). For assisting the senior citizens to live actively, purposefully and with dignity, we have created lots of entertainment avenues for them. The ***“Talk sessions”-(Bhalo Kothar Ashor)*** engages them in reading and knowing about lives and works of eminent people. Their participation in spiritual & philosophical exchanges, recitation, singing, creates a splendid atmosphere which enables them to rediscover themselves in the comfort of their home .

### 3. Educational SERVICES



- ❑ **Providing Primary Education** facilities to the children of the backward areas living alongside the river Ganga. Identifying gifted and talented children by engaging them in various art, craft and cultural activities of Kalyania.
- ❑ **Class room training** given to the children at the educational facilities in our premises.
- ❑ In order to inspire children of primary level to continue with **Higher Studies, Scholarships are Awarded to meritorious students** coming from poor economic background.
- ❑ **Non-conventional Teaching Methods** are adopted to train the women and children.
- ❑ **Adult Education Program.**
- ❑ Facilities for **Tailoring Training for women** to earn a livelihood and become self-reliant.
- ❑ In order to give a decent social upbringing to the rural children, training sessions on **Dance, Singing, Recitation, Drawing and Story-telling** are arranged so that they grow up as a good human being.
- ❑ ***"If you educate the women, you educate the whole nation"*** walking in these footsteps, we organize monthly ***"Mother's awareness"*** program to educate them to build a healthy society.

Based on the proposal of one of Kalyania's coveted life-member and a well-wisher, **Sri Prasanta Ranjan Sengupta** to start a coaching center in loving memory of his wife for girls studying in class IX to class XII and coming from poor economic background, we are happy to inform you that the coaching center named **Debi Sengupta Memorial Girl Students Coaching Center** was inaugurated on 29<sup>th</sup> January 2018. Thereafter, 10 students in each class have already taken admission.

A similar **Center** is already operational for girl students from class V to class VIII, aided by **Asha for Education (USA)** wherein 10 students in each class have taken admission.

#### **4. Other Awareness Programs**



- ❑ Encouraging people to pledge for donating their eyes and organs after death.
- ❑ Organizing seminar and “walk-for-cause” to create awareness among the general people about the importance of education, health, ignorance, prejudices and superstition in our society.
- ❑ Organizing mental health awareness programs for children.
- ❑ Assisting school going students with proper tutorials, particularly to those don't have learning support at home.

Successful accomplishments of social welfare projects, envisaged last year include :

- a) Training on Tailoring
- b) Projects on behavioral disorders of children
- c) Learning support and Teaching assistance for children.

#### **a. Tailoring Training Centre**

Under the able leadership of Sri Supriya Paul, Sri Ashok Baral and Smt. Kalpana Das, the women tailoring training center is run in small batches, with each batch consisting of 10 women. This training is absolutely free of cost and is arranged twice a year. After completion of the training, the trained women are allowed to work on their own at the Kalyania Training Center facilities to earn a livelihood. This is Kalyania's honest and sincere initiative to empower women to become self-reliant and earn a living on their own. We request all the members of Kalyania and our well-wishers to extend their whole-hearted support to these women by providing them work orders for tailor made items.

## **b. Awareness on Behavioral Issue in children**



During the last financial year, in order to create awareness on the behavioral complications in children, effective counseling sessions were held with the parents and teachers of 50 primary schools in Kalyani and its surrounding areas wherein '*Children's Behavioral Disengagement*' were discussed in detail. The parents and teachers were educated on this issue by a group of Doctors (Psychiatrists) and Psychologists belonging to a welfare organization named **Manab Sangbed** of Sodepur. We would like to extend our appreciation for the amazing and commendable work done by a team of Doctors and Psychologists. The endless hours put in by Dr. Gautam Banerjee and Dr. Prodipta Dhar (both Psychiatrist), and a team of Psychologists viz, Mrs. Tatini Dutta, Mr. Tarun Dutta, Mr. Sabujendranath Mukhopadhyay by covering all the 50 schools to complete the project have impressed and inspired immensely. The entire project is being successfully executed under the leadership and guidance of Project Head Dr. Partha Pratim Dhar, Assistant Project Head Sri Biswanath De, ably assisted by Mrs. Gayatri Chatterjee and Prof. Chitreshwar Sen, as the Advisor.

## **c. Teaching Assistance for School Children**

Children who are the first in their family to attend a school, known as first generation learners, may not get adequate guidance from their family as far as learning is concerned. Members of Kalyania have come forward in this venture to assist such children in their learning and studies so that they do not feel left behind. These classes are regularly held in Kalyania's own premises.

## 5. Kalyania's Educational Services



**Kalyania Suhasini Sishu Niketan**, a primary school run by Kalyania has received the primary affiliation from the Govt. of West Bengal but is not yet financially aided by the State Govt. The total count of students as on date is 113. The school stands as a trendsetter and is a front-runner as far as spreading the light of education among the poor children of the backward areas in the vicinity is concerned. Suhasini Sishu Niketan has flowered and bloomed under the dynamic leadership of its Headmistress, Mrs. Sati Choudhury, assisted by a team of committed teachers. In the matters of smooth functioning of the school the valuable advisory support and cooperation extended by Srimati Kabita Basu, Srimati Gayatri Chatterjee, Sri Sailendra Kumar Roy, Prof. Chitreshwar Sen, Srimati Chhaya Mandal, Sri Durgadas Banerjee and Sri Biswanath De has always been a source of motivation and inspiration for the teachers. The school is also blessed with the whole-hearted cooperation of the parents. We, at Kalyania, take this opportunity to applaud the sincere involvement and commitment shown by both the veteran and the young teachers of the school.

With the support of benevolent supporters we gave away **scholarships** to the needy and meritorious students starting from class V to Post-Graduate level.

## **7. Kalyania's Adult Education Centre**



Kalyania's objective of promoting adult education is to provide education to those who were deprived of formal education during their childhood and also to bring back their self-confidence so that they do not feel left behind. Our dedicated team who volunteered to take the responsibility of mentoring them is Srimati Gayatri Chatterjee, Smt. Kabita Basu and a very enthusiastic resident of Kalyania's old-age home, Sri Samir Chatterjee and Smt. Krishna Pal. The classes are held 4 days in a week from 4.00 pm to 5.30 pm and subjects like Maths, English, and General Knowledge are taught. Since these people are busy in their respective field of work, sometimes they are not able to attend the classes regularly, but they have shown tremendous interest and enthusiasm for learning.

## **8. Kalyania's Cultural Centre**

The smooth and efficient running of the School and Cultural Center can undoubtedly be attributed to the sincere involvement of Sri Sailendranath Roy, Asha for Education (USA), Triveni Tissue Ladies Forum, Kalyani Springdale School and a host of well-wishers. The students of Suhasini Shishu Niketan exhibited their talent and received lot of praise from everyone when they participated in the official parade held on Republic Day, or when they performed at the inter-school cultural festival hosted by Springdale school, or when they performed at the Kalyani Book Fair and also at the Banga Sanskriti Mela. Everywhere their performances were highly appreciated. The relentless effort of the Kalyania team responsible for exploring their talent and grooming the students to this level is indeed praiseworthy. Many a time, well-wishers turn up and bless the students with healthy food and colorful gifts.



### **9. Women's Self Dependant Projects**

Kalyania is determined to empower women and make them self-dependent through self-employment for a livelihood. Women who have studied upto class 8 are given in-house training on Nursing and Tailoring. Today, we are happy that many women have become self-employed and are earning their living independently. We are planning institutional/official recognition of these projects.

### **10. Awareness Sessions for Mothers**

It is very rightly said that when you educate a man, you educate a single person but when you educate a woman, you educate a nation. In line with this thought, awareness sessions for the mothers whose wards are studying in Suhasini Sishu Niketan are held on the first Saturday of every month, where we educate the mothers in various subjects, shape-up their general knowledge and teach them how to overcome the challenges they may face in raising their children.

### **11. Kalyania Old-age Home & Welfare Services for Senior Citizens**

At present the total number of aged and elderly boarders' are 27. At a reasonable cost, our honest effort is to enhance the quality of life of the elderly. We, with the help of our members and well-wishers, strive to create an environment where they can retain their dignity, self-respect, pride and self-confidence. The joy of active participation that transpires in their wrinkled faces gives a feeling of contentment that nothing else can. We also celebrate Bhai Phonta festival for the boarders. The school children from the vicinity arrive at our premises and apply tilak on their forehead. It is a momentous occasion which showcases the undying bond of love that exists between little children and our elderly boarders. Our sincere endeavor is going on to open a 'Day Care Center' for the aged people at the earliest.

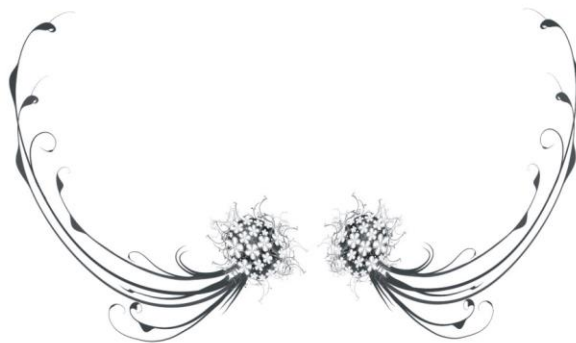

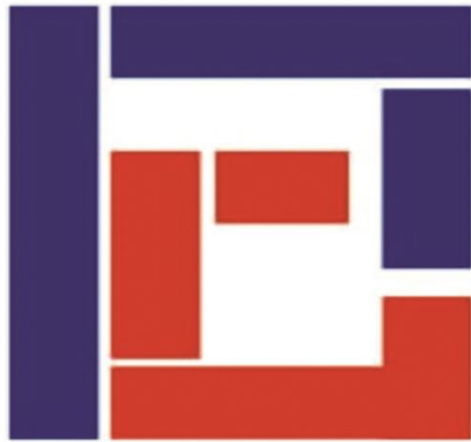
