SALIENT FEATURES OF OUR ACTIVITIES

- To provide health care to the children and elderly people in the unprivileged areas.
- To provide social security to the elderly people through KALYANIA OLD AGE HOME.
- Involve elderly people in meaningful activities through SIXTY PLUS CLUB and BHALO KATHAR ASAR.
- To spread basic education in the underdeveloped areas surrounding Kalyani amongst the children and continuous talent hunt through various cultural activities.
- Award scholarships to the needy and deserving children to encourage them to continue their higher studies.
- Unconventional training to the Mothers and Children
- Adult Education

- Organize Sewing Training to girls by professionals to make them self dependent.
- Encourage children from the backward class to participate in healthy cultural programme through drawing classes, Galpa Dadur Asar(Story telling classes), Recitation classes, Singing and Dancing classes.
- Encourage people to donate body and eye after death.
- Ambulance Service.
- Arrange seminars to educate people against social evils, ignorance, and on health and education.
- Organize Mother's awareness programme to educate them to build a healthy society.

In the previous financial year we embarked on a few new projects such as "Education Center for the Elderly People" and "Ladies Tailoring Center". Smt. Gayatri Chatterjee, Smt. Kabita Basu, Smt. Krishna Pal, Smt. Sanghamaitri Chattopadhyay and Smt. Utsa Sengupta are running the 'Adult Education Centre' satisfactorily. And the Sewing Training Centre for women is manned by Sri. Supriya Paul, Smt. Kalpana Das, Smt. Manjurani Bhowmick and Smt. Sarbani Mitra. To run these two projects we are getting financial assistance from "Asha for Education(U.S.A.)".

Reena Singh – A student of Adult Education Centre

For last one year I am coming to Kalyania's Adult Education Centre to attend to my classes regularly. Earlier, I could not even sign my own name. Now I can read and write fluently. My husband is an employee in The Kalyani Municipality. My husband and my only son encouraged me a lot for my studies. Besides my own enthusiasm suffices for everything. I have to go and work in the fields on daily wage to meet the house hold requirements. I don't like absenting from my classes but have to be absent for this daily-duties now and then. Earlier I used to feel inhibited in front of my neighbours to say that I was going to the classes to study but now I feel proud of my endeavour. The more of Primary Education begotten, the more of self confidence is brewing in me. We are very thankful to our teachers, who take a lot of care with patience and kindle the lamp of learning in our earnest hearts.



KALYANIA HEALTH CARE SERVICE

In the year 2014-2015, 8139 Nos. of patients were treated in various department of medicine in KALYANIA SURYYA KUMAR RAY CHARITABLE DISPENSARY. Latest addition to KALYANIA SURYYA

KUMAR ROY CHARITABLE DISPENSARY is **DIABETIC CLINIC**. Patients enlisted in this clinic find an opportunity to get free treatment once in a month (Last Wednesday of every month) under **Dr. S.B.Lahiri**, like the **Epilepsy Clinic** patients who receive treatment under **Dr. S.N.Banerjee**. Free medicines are provided to Diabetic patients as are done for like Epilepsy patients. Till now 86 Diabetes patients have been treated and were given free medicines. This year 725 patients were treated in Neurology department, 347 patients were treated in Ophthalmology department and 298 patients were treated in Dental department. Like last year, this year also, Health Check-up Camp was organized and 94 elderly people got an opportunity to get their health checked up. Under the stewardship of **Dr. S.N.Banerjee**, other medical practitioners like **Dr. (Maj. Gen.) D. K. Sen, Dr. Tapas Dutta, Dr. Debapi Roy, Dr. Biswajeet Sarkar, Dr. S.B. Lahiri, Dr. S.K.Karan, Dr. Kasturi Bakshi, Dr. Shanti Ranjan Modal, Dr. Tanuj Saha, Dr. Sabuj Pal, Dr. Subhashis Biswas, Dr. Tamal Banerjee and Dr. Partha Pratim Dhar** are devoting their precious time to KALYANIA SURYYA KUMAR RAY CHARITABLE DISPENSARY and also to other various free health check- up camps.

KALYANIA SURYYA KUMAR RAY AMBULANCE SERVICE is dedicated to provide service to the people of Kalyani. This year 87 people have availed of this service.

Besides this, KALYANIA provides E.C.G. MACHINES, NEBULIZER, SUCKER MACHINES, FOWLER'S COT, AIR BED and portable OXYGEN cylinder at a nominal cost to the needy patients. The demand for this service is increasing gradually.

Many eye patients were treated in the monthly eye camp organized by KALYANI EYE CARE AND LASER CENTER under the leadership of Dr. Debashis Sengupta. The camps were held in KALYANIA COMMUNITY CENTER.

Sevika Training Programme : **Sevika Training Programme** has been upgraded to **Sevika Training for Home Nursing**. The trained personnel are usually available for duty to the ailing seniors, sick or for child care on request to our Office at legitimate service charges. The total number of sevikas in pool at present is 40, of who are fruitfully engaged. We thank **Asha For Education (USA)** for giving required financial support to us for conducting such vocational training. This year good number of trainees completed Sevika Training for Home Nursing successfully.

Pampa Das – Sevika

I, Mrs.Pampa Das, do reside in Majherchar , Kalyani with my husband and a son. I am working as a 'Sevika' for last four – five years under the supervision of Kalyania. I am able to earn about Rs. Four/Five thousand approximately, in a month. Whenever it is needed, I help my husband financially. Time comes, I have to bear

the expenditure of my son's education for his Higher Secondary course. It is a matter of pleasure and prestige to serve as a 'Sevika' as well as gaining experience and education. I have undergone proper and systematic training as an 'Ayah' from Kalyania, which has made me self-sufficient. This training has given me great financial support to build a better future.

KALYANIA EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES

The teachers of KALYANIA SUHASINI SISHU NIKETAN deserve applause for their tireless efforts in teaching the children of the economically backward classes of the locality. It is to be noted that most of the students are first generation school goers. Since the inception of KALYANIA SUHASINI SISHU NIKETAN, Mrs. Kabita Basu steered the school in right direction efficiently and effectively. Recently due to her ailing health she has handed over the baton to Mrs. Sati Choudhury, Ex-teacher of Springdale School, Kalyani. One important information we would happily like to share with the members - that KALYANIA SUHASINI SISHU NIKETAN has now been approved by the West Bengal Board of Primary Education Board as a non-aided Primary School.

KALYANIA SUHASINI SISHU NIKETAN is being run mainly with the financial help of our Advisor Mr. Sailendra Kumar Ray, ASHA FOR EDUCATION (U.S.A.), ASTI (U.S.A.) and the benevolent donors. The members will be happy to know that the school which started with five students a decade ago has a strength of 90 students now. Some of the past pupils have now qualified in the Madhyamik Exam. and have been admitted in H.S. With the support of benevolent donors we give away SCHOLARSHIPS to the needy and meritorious students starting from class V to class X. We also lend one time financial support to students by paying admission fee to college. All this is possible due to generous financial support by donors from various walks of life.

Priyanka Malo – Std XI Merit scholarship Holder

I had started my primary education in Kalyania's Suhasini Sisu Niketan School. I was one of the first-batch students in the Sishu Niketan and that provided me into a strengthful plinth for the foundation of my education. Our granny-madam and other teachers had a unique technique of teaching us – sometimes very affectionate and at times bit strict in discipline- we had an enjoyable childhood under their guidance. All the financial liabilities remained with the school authority to bear our expenditure for education, so we also tried heart and soul to do well and prosper in life.

A remarkable change in attitude of the parents has also been noted! they have actively participated in all the programmes of the school as well as the cleanliness programme of the school.

KALYANIA CULTURAL CENTER

With the admirable help from the teachers of KALYANIA, the students of this organization are able to showcase their talent confidently on the same platform with the students belonging to well to do families. By now the students have exhibited their talent at the State organized Republic Day programme; they have also performed at the Kalyani Banga Sanskriti Utsav and on Durga puja. Among the teachers of KALYANIA ART SCHOOL, the earnest efforts of one of our old age home resident Mr. Harish Chandra Ganguly has enthused the children into literature through his story telling classes, 'Golpo Dadur Asor'. Seasoned artist Panchanan Pal's active participation has enriched the students of KALYANIA ART SCHOOL to draw and paint.

KALYANIA LADIES SEWING TRAINING CENTER

Aiming at self dependency of women Kalyania's latest venture KALYANIA LADIES SEWING TRAINING CENTER has taken shape. A shed has been constructed and some sewing machines have been donated by the members. 14 women have received training so far. We are confident that this will make a section of the needy women self-dependent in near future.

KALYANIA OLD AGE HOME AND SERVICE TO THE ELDERLY

With the funds collected for Kalyania Old Age Home corpus fund, extension of B-1/388 premises has been completed and presently 30 members are residing in our Old Age Home. It is appreciable on the part of Old Age Home residents for their direct participation in various social activities of Kalyania.

Through various cultural and seasonal programmes the old age home residents are involved into family-oriented thinking. 'Bhalokothar Asor's contribution to the entertainment of the old age home residents deserves special appreciation.

Throughout the year, Kalyania distributes old clothes, spectacles and other materials to the needy living around.

6. Generous donation are solicited for developing a routine diagnostic clinic, hypertension, E.C.G. and other chronic diseases.
