The AGM gives us the opportunity to meet you all at least once a year and enables us to interact and a general atmosphere of *bon homie* prevails.

The year under review in general has been a testing year as the Nation and the State passes through an atmosphere of uncertainty prevailing all over, leading to fund crunch, anxiety and general sense of discomfort that is not conducive to charity and charitable work. Yet we tried our best with a dwindling work force to keep up with the pace at which Kalyania has been growing in recent years. I have the pleasure to present before you what we have been doing during these testing times.

Before I formally present the report, let me state that our membership stands at 326 Life members. We also gained 14 Members during the year and lost Khaled Choudhury, Malay Kanti Naha, Bimalendu Deb, Dr. Sudeb Kr. Chakraborty and Commodore Prem Ranjan Sen through sad demise. Last year we also lost some Praveenabas inmates and wellwishers of KALYANIA. They are Gouri Mukherjee, Sudhindra Narayan Saha, Joydeb Mukherjee, Kajal Sengupta, Krishna Ray, Aparna Deb, Archana Deb and Dharendra Mohan Mukherjee. Let us stand in silent prayer for a minute for the peace of the departed soul(s).

**Background:** AS U ALL KNOW, Kalyania was established in 1998 with the objective of helping the slum dwellers irrespective of caste, creed or religion living along the Ganges belt bordering the township and help them establish themselves in the main stream of our society. We have highlighted our achievements in a brochure released during our Foundation Day (July 1) celebrations of 2012. From a room providing Outdoor Medical Service and another accommodating two seniors, we have grown into what we are at present. This is just the beginning. With your help and support we hope to be able to reach many more poor who need help.

### Salient features of our Activities during the year:

We prefer to present our activities classified into four modules.

**A. The Outdoor Clinic :** This Clinic provides multifaceted services to the suffering people through its several sections and patient footfalls in each are :

Our Medical Services also included:

- Health check-up of School children:** Dental check up held on 10/11/13 & 06/03/14
- Periodic Health Check up** of Old Age Home (*Proveenabas*) tenants held monthly
- Annual Health Check-up of Senior Citizens of the township:** Held on 18/01/2014
- Monthly Eye Camp:** Held on 2nd Tuesday of every month.

All these services are rendered by professional Doctors and support staff, all rendering voluntary services. All of them deserve our salute for their selfless services. The singular effort of Dr S. N. Banerjee, our President for running the Epilepsy Clinic deserves special kudos. The Governing body of Kalyania has planned to introduce a specialised **Diabetic Clinic** for poor patients very soon under the leadership of Dr. Sachibrata Lahiri.

(d) Kalyania has been running a **Sevika Training programme** which has been upgraded to **Sevika Training for Home Nursing**. The trained personnel are usually available for duty to

the ailing seniors, sick or for child care on request to our Office at legitimate service charges. The total number of sevikas in pool at present are 35, all fruitfully engaged. The training is cost intensive and requires funding or sponsorship. We request you to guide and help us in securing the much needed sponsors.

**B Free Primary and Supportive Education:** The nodal centre piece of this module is the Shuhasini Sisu Niketan largely sponsored by the benevolent Sri Sailendra Kumar Ray. This year 20 children were admitted to KG-1 (6 Male + 14 Female). The SSN is manned by 15 teachers and 3 support staff and is under the administrative control of Sm Kabita Basu strongly helped by Sm Sati Choudhury, Retd teacher, Springdale School. Ten children passed or migrated out this year and were helped and guided for admission to Governmental institutions for further studies.

Within this module, several Centres have been added to complete the education of the children of SSN and as also other children of different schools who do not get full exposure. These are

- The Kamala Sengupta memorial Computer Training Centre with 20 Students and two teachers
- School of Visual Art & Drawing with 150 intake and two voluntary teachers
- School of Performing Art , intake 30 with two voluntary teachers
- School of Vocational training with 7 trainees and 2 trainers. A new section of Sewing & Stitching Centre has been planned for experimental start in the coming financial year under this head.

Within this module are also Kalyania's efforts at supporting education beyond primary to the needy children through its pecuniary help programme by providing some monetary support. Today we have 30 Fellowships for different levels as desired by their sponsors. This programme is totally endowment dependent. These fellowships are tabulated in table 1.

**C Home for the Old and the Infirm:** The Proveenabas had seen some expansion and more comfortable accommodation in the expanded B-1/275 building and as also in B-1/388, B-1/396, & B-10/200. Today it accommodates 24 Residents (10 Male, 14 female). Kalyania endeavours to provide best of services to the residents through good food, helpline services,

and library-cum-entertainment services. The first two are attempted at par cost and as per individual requirements.

Interactive activities such as those enlisted below are our attempt at keeping these seniors involved and engaged. These include

- Friday evening prayers organised by the Ladies Forum of Kalyania
- Other social, religious and national events (non exclusive) in which our members of Proveenabas have the opportunity to fully involve themselves include (dates of these occasions)
  - Sarodotsava (09/10/2013)
  - Saraswati Puja (4th February, 2014)
  - Durga Puja (10th October to 14th October,2013)
  - Bijoya sammelani ( 19th October, 2013)
  - Rabindra Jayanti (9th May,2013 )
  - Foundation Day-cum-Dr B C Roy's birthday anniversary (1st July, 2013)
  - Independence Day-cum-Rishi Aurobindo birthday anniversary (15th August, 2013)
  - Rakshya Bandhan Utsav (20th August, 2013)
  - Teacher's Day (5th September, 2013)
  - Mother's Day (26th September, 2013).
  - Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose's birthday anniversary (23rd January, 2014)
  - Republic Day (26th January, 2014)
  - Antarjaatic Matri Bhasha Dibash (21st February, 2014)
  - Basantotsava (16th March, 2014)
  - Children's Awareness Camp (23rd to 27th September, 2014)

All these functions are participated by all (Students, teachers, Governing Body members and staff) with gusto and participants given a free hand to perform as they wish through singing, dancing, and recitations and always it ends with some snacks or meal. These are usually very memorable days for all who participate and particularly for the otherwise lonely residents of the Proveenabaas.

Governing body of Kalyania also proposed to introduce a “Sixty Plus Club” for senior citizens of Kalyania Praveenabas & Kalyani to ensure some mental relaxation and a Evening Coaching School for Adult Education.

**D. Miscellany:** Other than these primary modules, Kalyania, in association with others often undertake various other activities throughout the year. **These include:**

- Many members and other citizens often sponsor activities for the students, teachers and Old Age Home tenants that could be lunch, gifts or food packets. These sponsored programmes are enlisted in table 2.
- Other than distribution of used garments donated by members and/or citizens all through the year, annually, new garments are distributed prior to sharadotsava to the children of the SSN and Sunday Art School, Poor senior citizens, Members of Kalyani Blind School (Andho Alope Samity). Thus 510 people, old or young, received new garments on 05/10/13.
- Kalyania activities are strongly supported by the NCC/49 Battalion stationed at Kalyani over the years. They regularly (at least, once a month) provide food packets to the seniors in Proveenabas, medicines for the Out-door Clinic and often, shoes and socks to the children of SSN. Kalyania respects the Battalion for their charitable bend of mind.
- The children of SSN are invited by SDO/SDPO to participate in Republic Day Parade held each year on 26th January. They perform very well and often win laurels.
- Besides, these children participate in the cultural Section of various Melas organised by Kalyani Municipality or other bodies like the Kalyani Banga Sanskriti Mela (dt.09/01/2014), Book fair Mela (dt. 15/12/13 & 16/12/13). Here also the children win laurels.
- **Kalyania’s Appeal for Help:** Kalyania seeks your help as/for volunteers to organise these activities/sections or Doctors once a month for health checkup of residents

of Proveenabas or similar check-up of students of SSN and those programmes in a planning stage through provision of man-power, help or resources. The key areas needing help include:

- Outdoor Clinic: Manpower for sorting medicines, classifying and dispensing (prescription serving)
- Doctors at least once a week to strengthen the Outdoor Clinic including its various satellite clinics and for health check-ups
- Doctors to help run the Sevika Training for Home Nursing
- Teachers – particularly to help the support Centres like the Visual Art & Drawing, Computer Training, Performing Art or various Vocational Training programmes. You can plan and initiate a new programme if it is directed towards the benefit of the poor and the downtrodden.
- A coach(es) to initiate a Football Academy for the primary School children seeking collaboration with the Kalyani Municipality or the Kalyani Football Academy.
- Endowments for more scholarships for the poor, needy children of our society.
- People to visit once a week the Proveenabas to interact with its residents, read out books or current news or whatever to generate a sense of *bon homie* among these rather lonely citizens through proposed “Sixty Plus Club”.
- To man our Administrative Unit and help in administrative activities, keeping records, interacting with visitors etc.
- To organise our medical support service that includes the ambulance, wheel chairs, oxygen cylinders, Fowler’s cots etc
- To organise our Library and keeping records.


