## Secretary's Speech

It all started in February 2020. The apocalyptic spread of the Covid-19 pandemic across the world caused widespread concern, fear and stress among the people who suddenly found themselves in a changing and uncertain situation unfolding so rapidly in their lives and communities. A tidal wave of new data about the virus started cropping up almost everyday. But there were lots of debate and disagreement among the Scientists with regard to the acceptability of such data. The social media started spreading widely the various ways and means to kill the dreaded virus and the people in the grip of a rampaging Covid 19 tsunami, in a befuddled state of mind, desperately tried to latch on to those in a bid to stay alive ,however insignificant and worthless they may seem to be like bits of hay. Covid 19 pandemic introduced us with a flurry of words and phrases which were seldom in use before; one such word is 'Lockdown'. The complete absence of economic and commercial market activity due to lockdown adversely impacted people's lives and livelihood. Kalyania family prays for the peace of their departed soul. We also mourn the demise of those who succumbed to the coronavirus and pray for their departed soul to rest in peace.

Kalyania's welfare projects during the year 2020-21:

**KALYANIA PRABEENABAS (OLD AGE HOME):** Last year when the world was severely in the grip of the covid19 pandemic, it was a big challenge for Kalyania to keep the aged boarders healthy both physically and mentally as older people are more vulnerable to severe illness, especially those with pre-

existing medical conditions. At this time the Caregivers and the Members of Kalyania played a stellar role by being in the frontline of care giving. The elderly boarders of Prabeenabas also played a very important role by being responsive, understanding and cooperative to the services that were given to them by the Caregivers and Members. In order to take care of their mental health so as to keep them happy emotionally, various virtual entertainment activities and cultural programs were arranged for them, observing all Covid protocols.

Covid19 vaccination drive at Kalyania for the boarders, caregivers and staff was arranged on priority basis. Such a drive may not have been possible without the kind support of the District Magistrate and CMOH. We are indeed grateful to the District Magistrate and CMOH.

During the year 2020, at the request of the boarders, Durga Puja (only Ghot Pujo) and Saraswati Puja was celebrated on a low-key due to Covid restrictions. Covid guidelines were strictly observed due to the pandemic situation.

### **KALYANIA CHARITABLE DISPENSARY**

The able leadership of Dr .S.N. Banerjee and the relentless efforts of the doctors rendering selfless and noble health care services as far as practicable amid covid19 pandemic restrictions by observing full Covid safety protocols. In order to create awareness on Covid 19 disease and informing the community about the preparedness and adherence to preventive measures were frequently done by organizing seminars, distributing leaflets, pasting

posters, hanging banners and organizing roadside meetings. At the same time people were also advised on Covid appropriate behavior. Amidst of this covid19 pandemic situation, in order to ensure appropriate supply of oxygen, two nos. oxygen cylinders and two nos. oxygen concentrators were purchased through financial assistance from our partner Asha for Education (USA). Apart from this 2 nos. thermal gun and 6 nos. pulse oximeters were also purchased through financial assistance from Asha for Education (USA). Further, at the request of Asha for Education (USA) one no. Oxygen Concentrator was handed-over to Sargachi Ramakrishna Mission.

In this pandemic situation, the supply of oxygen cylinders and oxygen concentrators by Kalyania served as a source of great relief for the people who were in urgent need of them for Covid infected patients. This year, the total number of infected patients treated at the Suryya Kumar Roy Charitable Dispensary is 2016.

The students of Kalyania's Education Assistance Center (Shikhsha Sahayak Kendra), Mothers attached to the Mother Awareness Section (Matri Sachetanata Bibhag) and the Volunteers of Kalyania played a significant role by wholeheartedly participating in the Covid-19 awareness programs of Kalyania. In recognition of their work as Covid Warriors, all of them would be awarded with commendation certificates.

1139 family members of 39 Nos. of families who were kept themselves in home isolation during lockdown and 2000 Nos. of workers of Charsarati brick-kiln were served with cooked meals. Volunteers and staffs played a significant role in this massive activity.

The masks and the Face-shields made by the women of Kalyania Tailoring Training Centre have always been liked and appreciated in all corners of the town and healthcare centers. Masks and Face-shields were also supplied to healthcare centers situated outside Kalyani.

### **Kalyania Educational Projects:-**

Kalyania Suhashini Sishu Niketan has been completely closed for one year due to Covid induced lockdown announced by the Govt. For the young learners coming from the disadvantaged families, a school closure is seen to be having a profound impact on their learning and well-being. Children coming from economically challenged families could not afford to buy smart phones and also lack of internet connection in their homes made online learning from home a difficult task for them. In order to cope with this situation, study materials for the students were sent to their homes through their parents/guardian so that there is no learning loss. As a considerable number of parents are illiterate, parental supervision of studies at home became a big challenge for the primary students and due to this parental ineptitude their studies were severely disrupted. Hence, Mini School or Home-school was started for the primary students of Suhashini Sishu Niketan. These home-schools were started locality-wise in the house of a student or teacher where students living in that particular locality would come and study in a group of not more than 7 students. The security of the students and also Covid safety protocols were strictly taken care of. The children very well adjusted themselves in this new home-schooling environment. There has been active support from the parents coming from

disadvantaged families in running the home-schools. In addition to the existing teacher's strength of the Sishu Niketan, some extra teachers were also temporarily employed. The efforts of the teachers in this crisis are indeed commendable.

During this Covid Pandemic situation, food grains and nutritional foods were distributed from time to time to the students of Suhashini Sishu Niketan, Kalakendra and also to the students of Kalyania Coaching Center for Girls. Due to Covid Pandemic situation, dance, singing and recitation classes could not be conducted and hence had to be closed sine die, though we hope to resume the same soon. Kalyania Library is however open for public on all Sundays observing strict Covid safety protocols. Smart classes for Kalyania ASHA and Kalyania Debi Sengupta Coaching Center for Girls were conducted during the Covid-induced lockdown and running physical classes observing Covid safety protocols for Coaching Center for Girls was possible when lockdown was relaxed. The teachers got themselves vaccinated and in a bid to ensure that there is no disruption of studies for the girl students coming from disadvantaged families, they continued taking the classes risking their lives. Such brilliant efforts by the teachers are indeed commendable.

During this Covid-induced pandemic situation 45 Nos. of students were awarded regular monthly scholarships and some were given one-time scholarships. Students who received scholarships as well as the students of the coaching center put up a brave fight against Covid induced adversities which was indeed commendable. The financial assistance received from Asha

## Education-A Challenge during Covid 19

The Covid 19 pandemic situation has imposed a serious threat upon the world wide Education System. The Education of Kalyania- starting from a kinder-gartner to a high schooler- they all are trying to adopt themselves to different techniques owned now a days for imparting education in this unfavourable situation.

Formerly, discussions were centered upon the adverse affect of the excessive educational pressure on the overall development of a child, but at the backdrop of the pandemic the situations are compulsively bound to a restricted life, away from friends, attuning themselves to a absolute new educational system- where, some below poverty line students remain deprived of even that fortuity – which results in hampering the progress of education alarmingly.

In such dire condition, “Kalyania” (a Social Welfare Organization) has initiated the concept of “MINI SCHOOL”. Maintaining all the Covid measures and restrictions this “MINI SCHOOLS” has begun its journey locally in some under-developed area, with a limitation of seven students in each batch. The message for the Pre-primary class is - **“ Esho mora pora pora khela kheli”** and the message for the primary class goes like- **“ Griho kone pora shona mene niye poth chola”**. Other than this, around 81 eager students from

straitened background are regularly provided with coaching classes, at 'Kalyania Asha for Education' and 'Kalyania Debi Sengupta Memo. Coaching Centre for Girls' Shikkha Sohayak Kendra'-daily maintaining all the Covid measures.

Teachers, who have already received the covid vaccines are endeavouring hard to continue the educational progress of these impoverished students and barring drop-outs.

Kalyania Sewing Training Centre is also continuing its training mission/programming perusing all covid restrictions.

The hard-work and the dedication on the part of all our respected teachers who are determined to keep on the process of education, is really appreciable. At this current dim situation, participation of all responsible citizens are an absolute need to continue with the traditional educational system.

Apart from the Govt. and Non-Govt. sectors, the educated young members of our society, along with retired persons and home-makers may all contribute

to this "MINI SCHOOL" system of education, by helping one or two straitened students in their learning



procedure, which will assume a healthy education system in future.

## Role of the NGO, Kalyania during the Covid 19 Pandemic

At a time when the Covid 19 crisis continues to loom over us followed by the imposition of lockdown to contain the apocalyptic spread of pandemic, disrupted our normal life. At this great our need, volunteers of Kalyania stepped in to extend their helping hands to all poor beneficiaries of Kalyania. We mention below some of the relief and welfare activities undertaken :

- So far we have distributed around **2000 packets** of dry-food grains and **supplementary food materials to 500 families**, who are regular beneficiaries of Kalyania and **facing acute crisis in present state of emergency** with the support from Asha for Education, USA and other wellwishers. We have also distributed **2000 cooked food packets** in a span of 4 days amongst family members of brick –kiln workers of Charsharati, Nadia with the help of donations obtained from other well-wishers of Kalyania.
- **Trained women of the Sewing Training Centre** have worked hard to stitch 3000 pieces of three-layer washable face masks which were distributed, through mothers of our Kalyania Matri Sachetanata Bibhag & students of coaching centre, with an intention to raise awareness among people about the critical pandemic risk factors in the slum areas.



- In order to create awareness on the risk factors of Covid 19 pandemic four interactive seminars were conducted with the people living in nearby slums.
- Mother members of the **Kalyania Matri Sachetanata Bibhag** have been engaged in distributing **covid 19 awareness pamphlets** at micro level in different slum areas adjacent Kalyani.
- **Students and instructors of Kalyania Sewing Training Centre** deserves special mention for their sincere efforts for successfully launching cost price **FACE-SHIELD** for protecting our frontline Covid warriors. Both Govt. and Non-Govt. institutions are finding Kalyania Face shield very beneficial.
- Kalyania have also served **1139 free cooked packets to 39 Covid positive families** during their **home isolation** period. Staffs, students and members of Kalyania played a commendable role for **distributing** those to Covid sufferers.
- On 5<sup>th</sup> June, 2021 representatives of Kalyania went to **Puroshottampur Village**, one of the worst hit village of Mondarmani, East Midnapore to distribute food grains, nutritional supplements and garments to 100 families who lost their all belongings in Super Cyclone **Yash**.



All members and well-wishers of Kalyania deserve special thanks for their continuous moral, financial & logistic support for multifarious welfare projects of Kalyania.
