India Sponsorship Committee is working for the kids of Brick kiln workers in Yerawada, Pune.

The ISC program with the support from Asha for Education, Seattle, for the disadvantaged children continues to **focus on Education**, adding new aspects to cover components other than academics. Asha Seattle has been supporting this program since 2008.

In this current lock down situation they are planning to help around 200 families of the beneficiary kids with the dry ration and daily essentials. The grocery listed as below should be sufficient for ten to twelve days for each family.
