Community Based Rehabilitation(CBR)

In May our Physiotherapist - Himanshu Khurana and Special Educator – Shashi Narang teamed together to continue to take our Community Based Rehabilitation (CBR) initiative to villages Garauli Kalan and Khurd for detailed Case Studies and Counseling services at their door-steps.

They carried out - 4 Visits to the villages, 3 Home visits, 8 Therapeutic and counseling sessions

CBR-Survey

- **Orientation program was conducted at Khushboo for our special educators to carryout door to door survey in villages to identify those who could be covered under our CBR program.**
- **The ground was prepared by meeting the Village-Head, Anganwadi workers and teachers of the Govt. School of two villages Wazirpur and Garhi-Harsaru in Gurgaon District.**
- **A team of our special educators carried out door-to-door survey in their summer vacations in June to identify the children and others in the two villages. 12 cases were identified and short listed for CBR coverage.**
