Know About Sharmila

Sharmila joined in our Hariksha Learning Center on 19.06.2009, her parents are Jayaseelan / Yasodha, they are from Chekkidikuppam Village.

She studied upto 5th Standard in a Government Primary School. The school teacher brings her to our Learning Center for admission.

The school teacher gave us the information that she can memorize any number of rhymes, it is difficult to vary the colors & shapes. She has problem with eye co-ordination due to this she is not able to concentrate in any objects. She has the habit of using her left hand for all the activities. If we teach to hold the objects in right hand, she will hold it in the right hand but she use to shiver. She is dependent to her mother for all her day to day activities (bathing, grooming, self clean, etc)

Our continuous training and teaching makes her independent in all her day to day activities, she can able to put her dresses, she can put the buttons and take off it. After urination and use of toilets she can clean herself.

Now she can able to tell 30 Thirukural, many rhymes. If we teach her a paragraph text she can memorize it and able to repeat it. She can able to distinguish the colors, shapes exactly. She can say the Tamil Alphabets அ to ி. the days of the week, the months of the year, words அம்மா to எ.ஞ she can write the Tamil Alphabets அ to ி. & க to ன, she can copy her name, she can write the numbers 1-10. She can say 1-100 numbers, 2nd & 3rd table. She can identify the coins 1 Re, 2 Rs, 5 Rs and she can identify the Rupees notes 1, 2, 5, 10, 20, 50 & 100 Ruppes. She can arrange the five various pictures in order. She can fix all type of peg boards.

Periodical Parents Gathering

The periodical parents gathering conducted on 7th July 2012, 25 parents / relatives are participated in this group gathering. The two new members Sarathy and Marimuthu parents are introduced to all other parents. Each parents are individually called for discussion about their children's development, status, etc., The visit of ODM Foundation, for the assistance of Speech Therapy is shared with the parents. The parents are shared with the information that the uniforms and the footwear are all ready, will distribute soon to their children.

The SHG loan information are shared with the parents, the parents are provided with the information that Rs. 28,000/- is in Self Help Group bank account. Manigandan's aunty and Manimegalai's mother requested for the small loan. It is clearly explained to the parents that how importance to meet once in a month to know about the children status and share the information, so the absentees will be warned and if the situation makes them absent, they should inform it prior are after the meeting.

Purushothaman failed to come to our learning center for 7 days due to his health problem.

Kalaiselvi not attended our learning center through out July month.

We came in touch with Mrs. Berniece, ODM Foundation, France through Mrs. Anais LFDC Volunteer; she put forth all her effort to make collaboration with ODM Foundation. Mrs. Bernice visited our Learning center on 26th July 2012, 2 days she visited our Learning Center, one day she met the community workers.



This visit helps us to collaborate and get assistance from ODM Foundation for the speech therapy. She distributed the Learning Center Uniforms; Foot wears to the children on 26th July 2012.



In July month totally 12 members visited our Learning center and they provided with the information about our learning center.

The broken handles and minor repairs made in the wooden chairs are made corrected with the help of carpenter on 19th July 2012.

Field Visit

During the week ends the staff team members visiting the children houses to know the status of the children in the community and the parental neighbors approaches. In July the staff visited 7 children, are as follows;-

1. Gunapriya, during our last visit we instructed the mother to give attention to write the Tamil letter @, the mothers effort gives the good results that now she is writing the

letter. During this visit we informed the mother to practice her to write the Tamil ஐ letter, the father requested us to give more training to gain the speech.

2. When we visited Manimegalai's house she sat in front of the house and combing her hair. The family members shared us the information she gained more strength in her right hand. She use to cut the vegetables for cooking, she can able to cut the fire wood using the cutter. The grand mother complaints that she is not eating the vegetables.
3. While we visit to Ponmudi's house he is eating, the family members gives us the news that he is doing all type of household works. He use to bring the drinking water from the tap. Daily he use to study in the evening hours, he use to tell the English alphabets. The family members requested to develop the writing skill.
4. Praveen Kumar slept during our visit to his house. We met his elder brother, he shares us that he is not obedient to the family members, always he likes to watch Television and to eat. He can say the Tamil alphabets, we informed him to involve him to identify the Tamil alphabets letter. He can handle the cow and calf in their house.
5. We found only Ranjani's during our visit to her house, she slept in the cot wearing only the inners. She is untidy, not taken her morning bath.
6. Deepak played outside of his house, the father said that while he is eating he spills the food. He use to call his mother for his morning activities (ie., bathing, dress). We informed them to make him practice the English alphabets. He can write his name, he use to study in the evening hours with his younger sister. He is good in the simple addition maths, the parents are satisfied that they can notice improvements in Deepak activities.
7. Karthick makes the goats for grass in front of his house. The family members conveyed the information that he is not obedient to the family members, he is making quarrel with the neighbor children. He is asking money for his chocolates, if they gave 1 Re. he requires 5 Rs. We informed them to practice the time skill using the wall clock and make him to identify the Tamil Alphabets (we demonstrated it to the family members).

Building Construction

The pillars and beams of the building are framed, the building structure came up to 7 feet (Linton level).



The consultant engineer Mr. Baskar visited the construction assisted us for the strong and best quality construction.

We are very happy to inform you all that Mr. John, President, LFDC France raised fund for the Hariksha Learning center.
