Review Report of September & October 2012

Know the Child

Periaswamy, 12 Years, while he comes to our learning center he is very calm and lazy, he is dependent to all his daily activities. Now he is independent to all his day to day morning activities, ie., bathing, brushing, toilet skills and dress wearing. He shows much interest to come to our learning center. He is writing beautifully the Tamil alphabets $\mathfrak A$ to $\mathfrak A$, he shows good interest in studies, he understands the tasks, he is very much interested to complete the tasks and goals assigned to him. He says the tamil words Amma, Appa, Mama and Akka. He can able to count upto 25, he can identifies the rupee coins Re. 1, Rs. 2, Rs. 5. His skills are improving much.

Praveen Kumar, 18 Years, from Sindhipattu Village, Father Poongavanam expired in his child hood days, mother Kuppu is taking care of the boy and 2 elder sisters, 1 elder brother and one younger sister. Praveen Kumar admitted in our Learning Centre in his 15th year. Previously he was not attended any schools, if we show him a banana and ask him what it? He is not able to reply for it. He feels difficult to identify the colors, he is having difficulty to speak continuously, very often he gets angry. If we ask any question he uses to reply in one word answers. He is not able handle the money.

Now he is mingling with all, he can able to say the Tamil Alphabets, the numbers 1-100, two letters words. He can say the words Amma to Eggu in tamil, He can identify vegetables, fruits, colors and shapes. He can say the 7 days of a week, 12 months in a year. He can handle and identify the 1 Re, 2 Rs, 5 Rs, 10 Rs, 20 Rs, 50 Rs and 100 Rs. According to value he can arrange the rupees, he can tender exact exchange for Rupees uupto 30/- He can write the numbers from 1 to 20. He can write the Tamil alphabets, his name and address. He can color the ice sticks, he is fixing the two shapes solid puzzles. He is very much interested to sing the cinema songs and dance according to it.

DDAWO Visit

The District Differently Abled Welfare Officer Mr. Manoharan visited our Hariksha Learning Centre on 6^{th} September 2012.

The DDAWO Mr. Manoharan visited our Learning centre on 9th October 2012, DDAWO inspected the building construction. We provided him enough information about the progress of the building construction and the photographs.

On 15th October 2012 we submitted the application and necessary documents for the Teacher's Grant and Building Grant through the DDAWO, Villupuram.

Week End Home Visit

Abisheka Priyan, while we went to his house he played with the clay. The mother complaints that in house he is not doing the therapy. He is not mingling with his age group children for playing. He is insisting to buy DVD player. Without therapy his legs becomes contracted.

During our visit to Shanthi's house she uses to write in a note book. It is nice to see the note book she wrote the Tamil alphabets repeatedly. The parents are following our guidance and training her for the goals. We found that she is using the right hand to eat in our Learning centre, but in her house she is using the left hand to eat.

In R. Shalini's house we found she completed her bath and try to dress herself. In house she trying to speak Hindi, She is telling the value of 10 Rs, 20 Rs, 50 Rs, 100 Rs in Hindi. She is good in her studies.

The family members are not available in P. Shalini's house.

October 2012 the staff members made two home based visits on 2nd & 14th October. During this visit they visited Manjula, Arjunan, Mnopriya, Logesh, Gowtham, Purushothaman, Periyasamy, Gunapriya, Manimegalai, Vinitha and Akash House. The details are as follows,

Manjula's father said he is not aware about the improvements, he told to ask the mother, the mother said that she can say the simple words yes, no, Tamil Alphabets, they are feeling the improvements.

Arjunan, while we visit to his house he watched the television. The younger brother said that he can write the English alphabets, 1-10. The mother said that she don't want this son, if possible admit him anywhere, she don't want the maintenance grand. If any institution provides him good service with this money she is ready to admit him.

Manopriya's father said that they will be satisfied if their daughter walks good. They also requested that if the school van extension upto their village. They said that she can understand our communication, she does the works exactly what we say. They feel that improvements in her activities.

Logesh & Gowtham, while we went to their house they laid infront of their house after the bath. The mother said that without therapy they feel that the limbs are contracted, Logesh eating is not well.

Purushothaman played in his house, while we discussed with the father he said that he is using the vulgar words so he told to make discipline instructions. We provided him the information how to train the Tamil Letters in the house.

Periasamy played in front of his house, nobody in his house to discuss.

Gunapriya is making the clothes arrangement in her house. We teach the family members how to train with the Tamil Letter and numbers. They said that she is playing skipping rope, carom board, they requested that her speech is not clear, so make some arrangement for it.

Manimegalai, while we visited she alone in her house, no body is there to discuss.

Akash family members is not in house to discuss.

Vinitha sisters said that due to the abscess in the leg they are not able to sent her regularly to the learning centre. Now she is watching television continuously, she uses to bite every body, she is not listening the words of others.

Building Construction





The building construction is progressing, in September and October month the Government sanctioned the building grant. We got the confirmation order, the District Differently Abled Welfare Officer Mr. Manoharan, made a small pooja for this building on September 3rd, The building raised up to basement level in September. In October The building raised up to Linton level, the DDAWO visited on 9th October 2012 and the concrete completed on 20th of October, the main threshold fixed 18th October.

Our continuous supporter Mrs. Lakshmi Shridhar, from Navi Mumbai contributed Rs. 50,000/- On 14th October towards the building fund.



During the Ayudha Pooja celebration we thanked the staff for their service to the children and expected their fruitful co-operation forever. We provided gift to the staff, we provided them all with dresses, the staff felt happy.
