Project Background

- Extension of the Rescue Junction project in Gaya adopting their model
- Objective is to support under-privileged children who are at high risk for trafficking and abuse
- Provide them with basic necessities food, shelter, education and mostimportantly <u>PROTECTION</u>!
- The early intervention approach has proved to be the key to prevent children "disappearing" in to child labor or prostitution
- Rescue Junction has a remarkable record of rehabilitation of these children and reintroducing them to the education system

Project Highlights

- Supports up to 50 children aged between 7 and 17 years and over 700 direct child interventions since April 2019 (59% male and 41% female)
- Before Rescue Junction, these kids survived by collecting/stealing coal and selling petty goods/food
- Established a small outreach center (state and central government approved) that offers shelter, basic education, support and care
- Works closely with police and local authorities
- A key part of the process is the toll free 1098 childline number to report suspicions of abuse or for children to call for immediate help and assistance

Project Progress (and Hiccups) – last time (12/2019)

- Outreach center established in Koderma
 - Staff of 10 people, trained at Gaya; now working full-time in Koderma
- Rented place in September and staff working full-time in Koderma
 - 2BHK approx. 5 minutes walking distance from Railway Station
- 21 children in the center at the moment 17 boys, 4 girls
- Since September, 8 children (who were being trafficked) restored back to their family; 2 boys and 6 girls (within 3 months...)
- Unlike the Gaya Center, as per JJACT this center is still not Govt. approved
 - Still quite new; they're trying and working closely with the Govt.

Project Progress amidst Covid-19 and Amphan

- Outreach center established and running efficiently in Koderma; Currently there are 29 children at the center 21 boys, 8 girls
- In spite of Govt. Lockdown (Covid-19) and Amphan, Childline and Rescue Junction were fully functional (considered as Emergency Services); although the office remained closed
- Fortunately, they were unaffected by Amphan and have taken all the necessary precautions to prevent Covid-19 spread; so far everyone is healthy (asymptomatic)
- They have access to masks, sanitizer, soap and hand-wash for all team members and kids; Staff worked on rotational shift (limited basis) to maintain social distance
- The project partner is working with the Govt. on securing funding from the relief funds
- A site-visit was performed by Global Giving (Sarbojit Majumder) in November 2019

Big Impact – A Case Study

Story of Bhola

Some of you may be aware about Bhola who's first interaction with Rescue Junction was in the year 2009.

Bhola got separated from his mother at Patna Station as his mother got down to get water and the train started moving. He was 6 years old and some person took him as a servant. Some community members noticed this and contacted Gaya Rescue Junction. Rescue Junction team along with Local Police, intervened and took Bhola in their shelter. They tried to find his family but in vain. Nevertheless, with the help People's First Educational Charitable Trust (PFECT) Bhola was provided with education at Bodhgaya.

Recently this year in March, he appeared in Bihar State Class X Board Exam and he has high hopes that he will secure 1st Division (>60%). He wants to go to college for further studies.
