Another intended objective is to protect them from child labour. Children are also helped with a mid day meal.

The schools belong to an organization called Jagriti Bal Vikas Samiti, run by community of Indian Institute of Technology, Kanpur.

I, like my fellow villagers from Ranchi, used to migrate seasonally along with his parents to brick kilns of Kanpur, UP for livelihood. While our stay in Tatiyaganj area of Kanpur I attended the Apna skool education centre there and Completed my studies in Apna Skool till Class 4. I got selected in the first batch of kids in Apna Ghar, a residential hostel. Along with studies, I used to participate in dramatics and writing poems. I completed my education till Class 12 and then enrolled myself for graduation. I also worked as a teacher in Apna Skool during my graduation, teaching kids like myself for whom education was the only tool to break away from the vicious cycle of brick-kilns. I applied for MA (Education) programme of Azim Premji University and cleared the written exam and interview. Now I will be joining the Bangaluru campus this month for a new journey.
